

SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Church—as a voice of the Gospel—proclaims the sacredness of human life. Everyone fashioned in God’s image has “divine DNA” at the center of their souls. All have a place and because they have received the this gift. Nobody is to feel inferior, unworthy or unwanted. Even the most broken souls has a place. We,—the Body of Christ—have the privilege and responsibility to give voice to the voiceless. The homeless and hungry are equally sacred as the little ones in their mothers’ wombs. The migrant, the addict and those in prison deserve as much attention as the elderly, even those with hearts hardened by anger and resentment. All deserve respect and dignity.

The Gospel of Life is challenging. We would rather keep those we consider unclean as different or unfixable. Yet they have to belong. There is too much violence in this world as a result of the assault on human life. How different today’s Gospel story would be if Jesus gave in to what was “legal and acceptable” at that time. The leper would have been turned away, and a soul—already beaten down—would have experienced an even deeper wound. Jesus wouldn’t have captured much attention, nor would He have mirrored the Father’s compassion and love.

We understand that God’s vision is often in conflict with the vision put forth in our world and even the ones we advance ourselves. It is challenging to find a place for everyone at the table of life. This challenge is compounded when the systems of operation and structure that are so ingrained in us affirm **power and privilege** rather than inclusivity and justice. Everything really goes askew when the powerful control who can speak, who is entitled to wholeness and who is included.

When prejudice and entitlement raise their ugly heads, we find it’s time to admit that things have been a mess for a very long time. The mess needs to be healed, not by *erasing* it, but by allowing **God** to touch us and make us whole. There are no easy solutions to the world’s dilemmas. Knowing that wholeness, healing and dignity are worthy pursuits, we more confidently labor to achieve God’s vision.

PROCEDURES FOR ATTENDING MASS

Visit ctkevergreen.com to register. Sign up weekly from Sunday at noon until noon on Friday. Sign-ups are done each week on a first-come, first-served basis. When all the available slots have been filled, the site closes. The required limit follows local guidelines. Safe distancing face coverings and are required indoors. **Thank you for cancelling if your plans change or if you don't feel well, so that all will be safe and others may attend.**

MASS ATTENDANCE IN HALL IS FOR High-Risk ATTENDANCE ONLY: (Underlying Medical Conditions or 85 yrs or older)

- Sign up weekly (from Noon/Sunday until Noon/Friday) for either the 8:00 or 10:00 in the parish hall.
- Visit ctkevergreen.com to access SignUpGenius, or call the Parish Office (303-674-3155) if you do not have access to the internet. Sign up weekly Sunday-Friday.
- As in the church, masks must cover **both** face and nose.
- Reminder: this sign up is **only** for those individuals and their family members that are considered high-risk according to the CDC. Mass will be broadcast in the parish hall and the Eucharist will be brought to you at Communion time.

The 8:00am and 10:00am Sunday Masses will be livestreamed via the CTK website.

DISTRIBUTION OF ASHES

Due to pandemic restrictions, a modification will take place for the distribution of ashes this year. In Catholic cultures throughout the world, the custom is to sprinkle the ashes on a person's head. This is what will be done on Ash Wednesday.



If you simply must have the cruciform mark on your forehead, you can rub in the Sign of the Cross yourself, after you have received the ashes. For full details, see the complete article in our weekend missive. Since Masses have limited attendance, ashes will be distributed 9:00 am, 5:00 pm and 7:00 pm Masses. At the noon, 12:20 and 12:40, we will have a brief Scripture Service followed by distribution.


