BAPTISM PREPARATION

Regarding the Restored Order of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and then Holy Communion, both parents in their role as "first and best teachers to their children the ways of the Faith" must attend this class. HOLY MATRIMONY

Archdiocesan norms require 9 months preparation. To have the ceremony take place at CTK, either the bride or groom must be a CTK member (or their parents), that is, they must reside within the boundaries of our parish. No wedding date may be set until after an initial interview with the pastor. Note: sacramental Catholic weddings take place in the church.



THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Rather than allowing the mystery of being created in the image of God unfold and take root in our lives, we sometimes change the dynamic. We make God into the image we want God to be. We have a hard-enough time letting the people in our lives be who they are. Who is it that we want God to be: a protector, disciplinarian, champion for justice, healer, advocate for our cause, grantor of prayers, guardian of my life, or the avenger? Our prayers tell an interesting story.

Allowing God to reveal what divine life actually is offers a renewed and healthier relationship. We can spend so much time storming heaven with our needs and agendas—trying to make God into a “god” of our desires—that we do not hear God saying, “Listen to me!” God is saying, “I am here among you as One who is a community of persons, a family of persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. In that image we are created, nurtured and restored.

Many people seldom notice God’s presence because they are so caught up with their spiritual cares and concerns. And, when the “god” they fashion and create doesn’t produce as they desire, they will move on. “I tried,” they exclaim, “but God didn’t listen.”

Healthy relationships aren’t built on making someone be who we need them to be. Instead, they are built on encounters of persons. An appreciation of someone solely for who they are develops. Deeper relationships can be found with two people marveling at each other and almost experiencing a childlike joy and giddiness when they see the other coming. Do you ever have these feelings about God? Believe it or not, God does for you! There is a joyfulness that gives rise to and connects us with the Holy Trinity. It is this heavenly love—flowing from the very depths of the Godhead—that not only keeps the Trinity in unity, it spills over into the creation of all beings and things. It is an expression of Divine Delight! Let’s take time away from our concerns and agenda, and experience this Divine Joyfulness of God.

We can reach a connection of Presence wherein even the smallest of creatures suddenly radiate the fullness of God: the wonderful creation of their being, the innocence and playfulness of their movements, and the sustaining life breath that flows through their veins. UPDATED MASS PROCEDURES

We now have different procedures in place regarding masks:

- For those who have been fully vaccinated for two (2) weeks or more OR have contracted the virus within the last six (6) months, masks are still encouraged, but optional.
- For those not comfortable being indoors around people without masks, seating in the parish hall will be available for the Sunday simulcast Masses. Note also: there is always ample room at the 4:00 pm Sunday Mass.
- For the sake of those attending the simulcast/overflow Mass on Sunday morning, please wear masks while in the parish hall.
- Since there is sufficient spacing at daily Mass, wearing/not wearing a mask is your choice.

We continue to simulcast both Masses in the hall, but livestream only the 10:00am Mass each Sunday.
