
SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

If you or a loved one is preparing for surgery, please contact Fr. Jim. If death is pending, unless a turn for the worst is sudden, please give ample notice so we can be sure to arrive in time.



BAPTISM PREPARATION

Regarding the Restored Order of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and then Holy Communion, both parents in their role as "first and best teachers to their children the ways of the Faith" must attend this class. God-parents of good standing are also required to take the class at their parish. For online options for Baptism Prep sessions, contact the Parish Office.



HOLY MATRIMONY

Archdiocesan norms require 9 months preparation. To have the ceremony take place at CTK, either the bride or groom must be a CTK member (or their parents), that is, they must reside within the boundaries of our parish. No wedding date may be set until after an initial interview with the pastor.
Note: sacramental Catholic weddings take place in the church.

THE MOST HOLY BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST

Creation is in God's image, and yet, our world always faces factions in every age. It is important to remember always who God is. We get distracted and lose focus, pulled in so many directions. We not only lose sight of God, but of one another. Developing a relationship with God and others is essential to be fully alive. In a message to young people, Pope Benedict XVI said, "The happiness you are seeking, the happiness you have a right to enjoy, has a name and a face: it is Jesus of Nazareth, revealed in the Eucharist." Regardless of how the particulars of life change over time, human beings are hard-wired to seek this fullness of life and happiness. Food for the journey is imperative.

There is much brokenness and pain in our world. Every time we receive the Body of Christ broken for us, we are expected to become what we eat. The power and presence of Christ in the Eucharist becomes more alive in us, and effects a change in who we are to be for others. In this Bread-come-down-from-heaven, we are given grace to become living temples of justice and peace, to carry God's sacred Presence to the same broken people Jesus touched and healed.

Our portion of the Body of Christ—this faith community—is granted the fire of God's love and must stand as a sign of hope in a world that is lost. This hope, with which we are fed, helps us discover peace-filled resolutions to violence, and guides us to create lasting solutions to whatever is in need of God's divine touch. True happiness, for the young and old alike, becomes an obtainable goal.

St. John Maria Vianney says it so well: "There is nothing so great as the Eucharist. If God had something more precious, He would have given it to us." The Eucharist has the ability to connect and strengthen us, not only on the road of this life; it leads us to that feast of the heavenly banquet.

Aware of who and what we consume, we can rely on this sustaining gift when life is challenging and unsettling; for truly, this is the Real Presence of Christ. This actual encounter with God Incarnate honors God's unconditional love for all every time we celebrate this Mystery. It grounds us in the truth of who we are and what we are to do. Becoming more completely "The Body of Christ," we are uniquely bound to one another as that Body. Nourished, united and strengthened by the Eucharist, let us—individually and as His Mystical Body—bring this wonderful gift to all we meet, especially the poor with whom Jesus has a transforming and special connection. © LPi revised

UPDATED MASS PROCEDURES

We now have different procedures in place regarding masks:

- For those who have been fully vaccinated for (2) weeks or more OR have contracted the virus within the last six (6) months, masks are still encouraged, but optional.
- For those not comfortable being indoors around people without masks, seating in the parish hall will be available for the Sunday simulcast Masses. Note also: there is always ample room at the 4:00 pm Sunday Mass.
- For the sake of those attending the simulcast/overflow Mass on Sunday morning, please wear masks while in the parish hall.
- Since there is sufficient spacing at daily Mass, wearing/not wearing a mask is your choice.

We continue to simulcast both Masses in the hall, but livestream only the 10:00am Mass each Sunday.


