
SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

BAPTISM PREPARATION

Regarding the Restored Order of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and then Holy Communion, both parents in their role as "first and best teachers to their children the ways of the Faith" must attend this class. God-parents of good standing are also required to take the class at their parish. For online options for Baptism Prep sessions, contact the Parish Office.



HOLY MATRIMONY

Archdiocesan norms require 9 months preparation. To have the ceremony take place at CTK, either the bride or groom must be a CTK member (or their parents), that is, they must reside within the boundaries of our parish. No wedding date may be set until after an initial interview with the pastor.
Note: sacramental Catholic weddings take place in the church.

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Maybe the work is best left to the professionals. That's how many people view the preaching of the Gospel. That's the stuff professional Church people do. It has little to do with me. Well, that's not really true. The fact is that preaching **kerygma** of the Gospel has **everything** to do with all of us, all the baptized members of the Body of Christ. Nobody gets off the hook. The question: how do we do it? The **safe way** pretty much keeps the Gospel in church and around like-minded people: I say my prayers, go to Mass, contribute to the food pantry, tithe, and attend Bible Study. That pretty much covers it.

The **risky way** is the more challenging, and for many, 'tis the "road less traveled." Imagine those first Christians going out into society and into people's homes. They must have had some amazing conversations about God's kingdom, changing hearts, forgiving sins, and looking at the world with the eyes of Christ. They must have met people who were hurting, exiled from their communities, neglected or lost; people living self-insulated lives while neglected the poor. While there were many who welcomed the **kerygma** (created, captured and ransomed), there were others who no doubt rejected them and literally tossed them out as their response! The Gospel, while being a message of joy and hope, is not always received well by those who are very comfortable keeping things as they are.

The risky way involves example and conversation. We take the Gospel wherever we go. When we interact with others, what is the focus of our word? If we are sincerely interested in announcing God's vision for the world, we will talk about it. It will become a part of our everyday conversation and find its way into our interactions with others. How do we encourage others to have a relationship with God, preserve the dignity of human life and promote the good common to all? By striving to be examples of value centered and virtuous living, which only comes through constant, surrender to God, as we seek to stand against injustice and learn ways to resolve conflicts without violence. If we are going to succeed going forward, we have to find a way to bring our prayer centered lives into the marketplace. Not everyone wants to hear what the Gospel has to say.
