#### BAPTISM PREPARATION

Regarding the Restored Order of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and then Holy Communion, both parents in their role as "first and best teachers to their children the ways of the Faith" must attend this class. Godparents of good standing are also required to take the class at their parish. For online options for Baptism Prep sessions, contact the Parish Office.



#### HOLY MATRIMONY

Archdiocesan norms require 9 months preparation. To have the ceremony take place at CTK, either the bride or groom must be a CTK member (or their parents), that is, they must reside within the boundaries of our parish. No wedding date may be set until after an initial interview with the pastor. Note: sacramental Catholic weddings take place in the church.

Please contact Fr. Jim before setting any dates. We need to coordinate with our ministries and funeral directors, and to ensure that the facilities are available for that day.






EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

“You cannot see the forest for the trees” is a widely known saying that can bring wisdom to our understanding of our journey. Often, our sight becomes limited to what is immediately before us. We lose touch with lessons and experiences from the past and promises and hope for the future. As human beings, we often have the privilege of being able to choose what we want and don’t want. Our preferences can begin to define us more than the fact of simply being. If we don’t move beyond the external and superficial stuff to what really is of essence, we risk becoming very unsettled, even angry and unhappy. We fail to see the bigger picture of hope and promise that lies ahead, and the Divine Presence that has sustained and carried us before.

Even the people who witnessed Jesus feed the five thousand got confused and distracted. It felt good when thousands of people were able to eat. They wanted to know what they could do to get this to happen again. Jesus quickly reminds them that this is not the point of this sign.

Jesus is the true bread come down from heaven. He is the incarnate presence of the God who sustains life and assures us that we will not perish. This is not always easy to understand or to feel. As with the repetition of Sacred Liturgy, we have to practice through repetition being in the presence of the Holy. Eucharist helps us to **remember**, so we can encounter the sacredness of being. This is real prayer.

Then, as we learn to trust, we cease to become afraid and uncertain so quickly, as well as being overly self-concerned and grumbly. God has our back. That is the essential powerful message of the Living Bread Come Down from Heaven. God in the flesh—who is alpha and omega—the beginning and the end, also has everything in between in the divine care for us, and all creation as well.

A woman once remarked that her most powerful God-moment happened when she and her husband cuddled with their new baby for a time. Without exchanging words and using only the affection communicated through sight and touch, they rested in being with each other. This brought them to the sacred, where they realized that God was with them. They knew that they were part of something bigger, intimate, and profound. At the Mass, we too can feed on the Divine Presence, which will not only help us rest in God of Life; we will also find ways to touch the souls of those who are hungry or thirsty for God. © LPI revised
