Bulletin Reflection for Sunday, January 23, 2022



Ezra and Nehemiah were breaking open God's word to instruct the Israelites. They had recently returned from exile and had not been instructed in law that had been given to the Jews. They eagerly heard the scriptures proclaiming the Law God had given the people. When they heard it there was sadness and weeping. Perhaps they realized how high God's standards for them were and how far off the mark they were. But Ezra and Nehemiah told the people to rejoice and to realize how much God loved them and was their strength. Sometimes we focus on how we fall short and wonder if God loves us in our broken condition. We are reminded that His love and mercy always await us. Rejoice!

The reading from first Corinthians emphasize that we are all necessary in the Body of Christ. There are different gifts and ministries, but all are needed and important. As Paul says: "If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it, if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy." We have different strengths, but all are indispensable. Do we appreciate how each person contributes and enriches the body, or if we fail to use our gifts how the Body of Christ suffers because a need is unmet?

Jesus taught in the synagogue using the scriptures. The truth of the scriptures, and the fulfilment of them was evident in Jesus. Do we let Jesus' teaching penetrate our hearts, and make a difference in our lives?

Esdras y Nehemías estaban rompiendo la palabra de Dios para instruir a los israelitas. Escucharon con entusiasmo las Escrituras proclamando la Ley que Dios le había dado al pueblo. Cuando lo escucharon hubo tristeza y llanto. Tal vez se dieron cuenta de cuán altos eran los estándares de Dios para ellos y cuán lejos estaban de la marca. Pero Esdras y Nehemías le dijeron a la gente que se regocijara y que se diera cuenta de cuánto los amaba Dios y era su fortaleza. A veces nos enfocamos en cómo nos quedamos cortos y nos preguntamos si Dios nos ama en nuestra condición rota. Se nos recuerda que Su amor y misericordia siempre nos esperan. ¡Alegrarse!

La lectura de los primeros Corintios enfatiza que todos somos necesarios en el Cuerpo de Cristo. Hay diferentes dones y ministerios, pero todos son necesarios e importantes. Como dice Pablo: "Si una parte sufre, todas las partes sufren con ella, si una parte es honrada, todas las partes comparten su alegría". Tenemos diferentes fortalezas, pero todas son indispensables. ¿Apreciamos cómo cada persona contribuye y enriquece el cuerpo, o si no usamos nuestros dones, cómo el Cuerpo de Cristo sufre porque una necesidad no está satisfecha?

Jesús enseñó en la sinagoga usando las Escrituras. La verdad de las Escrituras, y el cumplimiento de ellas era evidente en Jesús. ¿Dejamos que la enseñanza de Jesús penetre en nuestros corazones y haga una diferencia en nuestras vidas?
