



From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Friends in Christ,

As a child of the South, I remember well hearing about Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. He helped peacefully transform not only the South but the entire nation, pricking the consciences of us all. Many neglect to remember this great man was also a Baptist minister who had a deep understanding of the Holy Scriptures. You can hear within his wise words the ringing of truth and justice and right. Hospital Visitations

If you have need of a visitation for yourself or a Catholic relative or friend at San Juan Regional Medical Center, please call Rev. Linda Stetter, hospital chaplain, to be placed on the visiting list. Please call her prior to my Wednesday afternoon visits at (505) 325-5011 and ask for her by name or ask for the "hospital chaplain." She will answer swiftly but if she is busy with patients and does not answer, simply leave a message with your name and phone number and she will return your call.

Due to the terrible overload of Covid patients in the hospital at this time, I am blessed to visit all patients, including the Covid patients, and am happy to anoint them and give them communion and to visit with them. But I can only do this at 1 p.m. on Wednesdays, so it is imperative for you to contact Rev. Stetter and let her know you wish yourself or your loved ones to be visited. I am allowed to make an emergency visit to the hospital if someone is dying, but again Rev. Stetter must be contacted in order to have the hospital let me visit.

We must follow protocol in these unique times. Covid and its many variants are very dangerous and so I am allowed to make visits but Rev. Stetter must go with me. She is wonderful in her service to God's people no matter what faith tradition and she helps me suit up and put on special headgear in order to enter Covid rooms. That is why you must contact her so that I can enter the hospital and so she can help me suit up properly for my protection and for the protection of the patient or patients I visit. Thank you.


