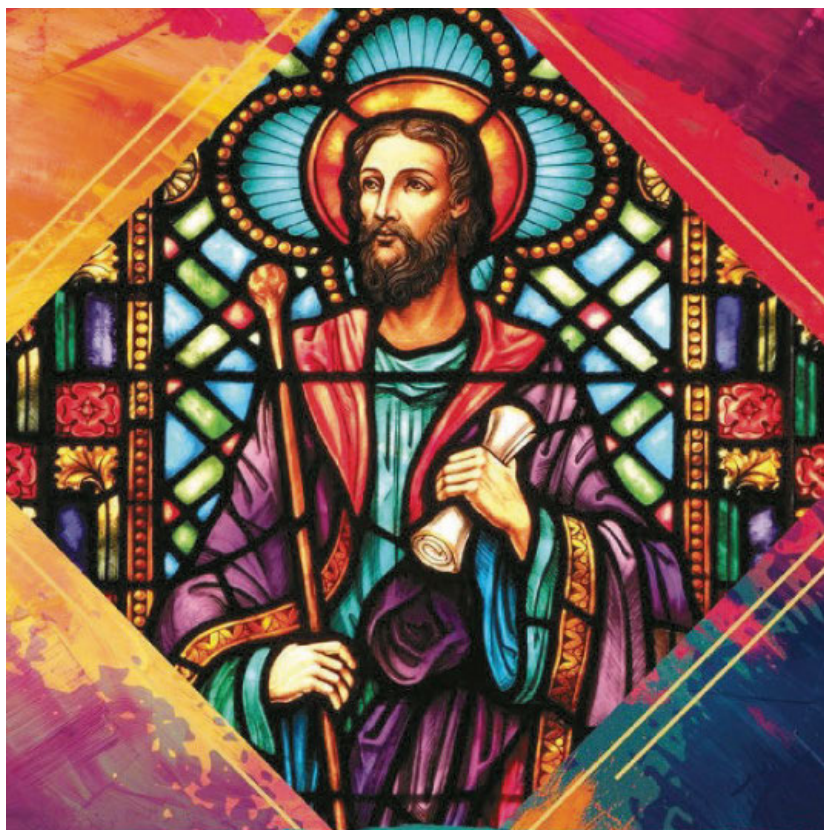

#### Love as a Theological Virtue

I've heard that love is a theological virtue. What does that mean?

Charles Shultz, the creator of the Peanuts comics wrote, "I love mankind ... it's people I can't stand!" This good humored comment gets at an important truth. St. John wrote a very strong statement in one of his letters: "If anyone says 'I love God,' but hates his brother, he is a liar; for whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen" (1 John 4:20). How often do we say "I love the homeless," but ignore the parish food drive? Or insist on the importance of respecting others, but don't bother to say hello to our cashier? If we can't love an individual person, we might not love people like we think, and we certainly need to work on our love for God.

Love is "the theological virtue by which we love God above all things for His own sake, and our neighbor as ourselves for the love of God" (CCC 1822). God knows acts of love of Him and others isn't always easy. So He invites us to pray for the grace to do it. The virtue of love gives us the grace and strength we need to offer our lives to God and love people in our lives, especially those who are difficult to respect, tolerate, and care for. Real love, of course, is risky. Real love wills the good of the other when we just want good for ourselves. Real love gets up on the cross when we'd prefer to take a nap in Gethsemane. Real love changes things.

## El Amor Como Virtud Teologal

He oído que el amor es una virtud teologal. ¿Qué significa eso?

Charles Shultz, el creador de los cómics de Peanuts, escribió: "Amo a la humanidad... ¡Es la gente que no soporto!" Este comentario de buen humor llega a una verdad importante: San Juan escribió una declaración muy fuerte en una de sus cartas: "Si alguno dice: 'Amo a Dios', pero odia a su hermano, es un mentiroso; porque el que no ama a su hermano a quien ha visto, no puede amar a Dios a quien no ha visto" (1 Juan 4:20). ¿Con qué frecuencia decimos "Amo a las personas sin hogar", pero ignoramos la colecta de alimentos de la parroquia? ¿O insiste en la importancia de respetar a los demás, pero no se molesta en saludar a su cajera? Si no podemos amar a una persona en particular, es posible que no amemos a las personas como pensamos, y ciertamente necesitamos trabajar en nuestro amor por Dios.

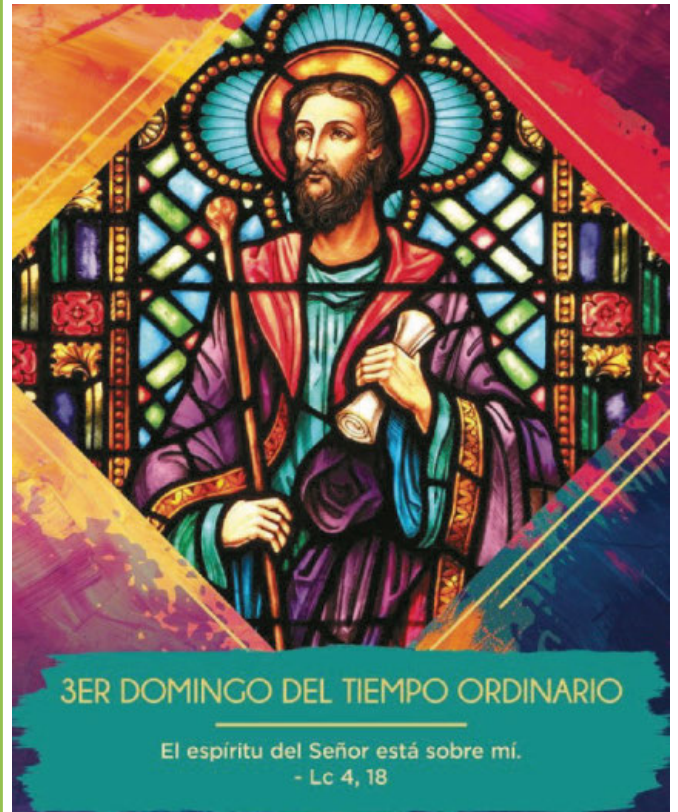
El amor es "la virtud teologal por la cual amamos a Dios sobre todas las cosas por amor a sí mismo, y al prójimo como a nosotros mismos por amor a Dios" (CIC 1822). Dios sabe que los actos de amor a Él y a los demás no siempre son fáciles. Así que nos invita a orar por la gracia de hacerlo. La virtud del amor nos da la gracia y la fuerza que necesitamos para ofrecer nuestras vidas a Dios y amar a las personas en nuestras vidas, especialmente a aquellas que son difíciles de respetar, tolerar y cuidar. El amor verdadero, por supuesto, es arriesgado. El verdadero amor desea el bien del otro cuando nosotros solo queremos el bien para nosotros mismos. El verdadero amor se levanta en la cruz cuando preferiríamos tomar una siesta en Getsemaní. El amor verdadero cambia las cosas.

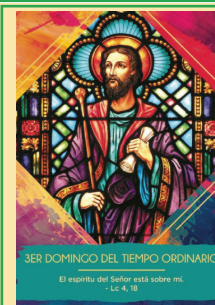

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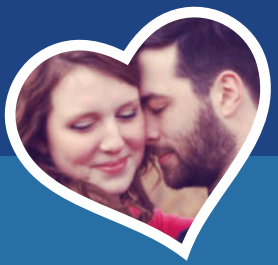
