“Get behind me, Satan!”

After the Apostle Peter confessed his faith: **“You are the Messiah”**. Upon hearing the Lord’s announcement of his passion, he was the first to reject the path the Lord proposed: “to deny oneself, take up the cross, and follow him.” The kingdom of God has its demands, and the disciples must learn that the cross is part of the commitment to make the Kingdom of God present in this world.

The Apostle Peter does not understand the Lord’s messianism, and just as Satan sought to lead the Lord Jesus astray in the wilderness, now the Apostle wants to do the same. The Lord says to him, “Get behind me, Satan.” That is to say, do not lead me astray from my Father’s path. The apostle thinks of power, prestige, and dominating others.

The Lord Jesus is God’s prophet, and, as Jeremiah teaches, one cannot abandon God’s plan. Faced with the apostle’s negative attitude, the Lord’s reaction is very strong, and He rebukes Peter harshly: “Get behind me, Satan.” He reminds him that he is a disciple and that he must not tempt Him and concludes with these powerful words: “Your way of thinking is not God’s, but that of human beings.”

To follow the Lord Jesus is to renounce our human standards and personal certainties that stand in opposition to God’s plan. Lord, help us to carry our cross and follow you with love!

“Apártate de mí, Satanás.”

Después de que el Apóstol Pedro confesó su fe: “Tú eres el Mesías”, al escuchar el anuncio de la pasión del Señor, fue el primero en rechazar el camino que el Señor propone: “renunciar a sí mismo, tomar la cruz y seguirle”. El reino de Dios tiene sus exigencias, y los discípulos deben aprender que la cruz es parte del compromiso de hacer presente el Reino de Dios en este mundo.

El apóstol Pedro no comprende el mesianismo del Señor y, al igual que Satanás, quiso desviar al Señor Jesús en el desierto, ahora el Apóstol quiere hacer lo mismo. El señor le dice: “Apártate de mí, Satanás.” Es decir, no me desvíes del camino de mi Padre. El apóstol piensa en el poder, el prestigio y en dominar a los demás.

El Señor Jesús es el profeta de Dios y, como Jeremías enseña, no se puede abandonar el proyecto de Dios. Ante la actitud negativa del apóstol, la reacción del Señor es muy fuerte y reprende con dureza a Pedro: “Ponte detrás de mí, Satanás.” Recuerda que eres discípulo y que no puedes tentarme, y termina con unas tremendas palabras: “tu modo de pensar no es el de Dios, sino el de los seres humanos.”

Seguir al Señor Jesús es renunciar a nuestros criterios humanos y seguridades personales que se oponen al proyecto de Dios. ¡Señor, ayúdanos a cargar nuestra cruz y seguirte con amor!
