Giving Your Whole Livelihood

Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time (Year B)

Jesus sat down opposite the treasury and observed how the crowd put money into the treasury. Many rich people put in large sums. A poor widow also came and put in two small coins worth a few cents. Mark 12:41–42

If you were in charge of the Temple treasury, which would you prefer? The rich putting in large sums of money? Or one poor widow putting in two small coins? Of course, an honest answer to that question might be hard to give. Much good can be done with large sums of money, right? Wouldn't it be better to accept more than a few cents? The dilemma one would experience in this situation reveals a misperception that we regularly encounter in life. Is more better than less? Is wealth better than poverty? Is success better than failure? It all depends upon the spiritual reality at hand.

The poor widow gave more than two small coins; she also gave the spiritual gift of her generosity and complete trust in God. She gave all she had and trusted that God would take care of her and use her gift for good. This is infinitely more fruitful for the building of the Kingdom of God than the gift of someone's excess of money. God does not need our money, but we need to give it, be detached from it, and be ready and willing to give everything we have, all that we are, our entire livelihood to God. This is trust. This is a spiritual gift that will have far greater eternal ramifications for the salvation of souls than all the money in the world.

Reflect, today, upon the compliment Jesus pays to this poor widow. "She, from her poverty, has contributed all she had, her whole livelihood." Do you contribute your whole livelihood? Do you dedicate everything you have, all your energies and gifts, and all that you are to the service of God for His glory? We are called to give everything to God – not just a portion of our lives. Reflect upon how well you imitate this poor widow and seek to follow her holy example.

Most generous Lord, You gave all that You had and all that You are out of love for the salvation of the world. Help me to imitate Your total gift by returning all to You, entrusting my entire life, all that I am, and my entire livelihood to You. Jesus, I trust in You.

Dando todo tu sustento

Trigésimo Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario (Año B)

Jesús se sentó frente al tesoro y observó cómo la multitud ponía dinero en el tesoro. Mucha gente rica pone grandes sumas. Una viuda pobre también vino y puso dos moneditas que valían unos pocos centavos. Marcos 12:41–42

Si fueras el encargado de la tesorería del Templo, ¿cuál preferirías? ¿Los ricos invirtiendo grandes sumas de dinero? ¿O una viuda pobre que pone dos moneditas? Por supuesto, una respuesta honesta a esa pregunta puede ser difícil de dar. Se puede hacer mucho bien con grandes sumas de dinero, ¿verdad? ¿No sería mejor aceptar más que unos pocos centavos? El dilema que uno experimentaría en esta situación revela una percepción errónea que encontramos regularmente en la vida. ¿Más es mejor que menos? ¿Es mejor la riqueza que la pobreza? ¿Es mejor el éxito que el fracaso? Todo depende de la realidad espiritual que se tenga a mano.

La pobre viuda dio más de dos moneditas; también dio el don espiritual de su generosidad y de su plena confianza en Dios. Dio todo lo que tenía y confió en que Dios cuidaría de ella y usaría su don para bien. Esto es infinitamente más fructífero para la construcción del Reino de Dios que el regalo del exceso de dinero de alguien. Dios no necesita nuestro dinero, pero nosotros necesitamos dárselo, desprendernos de él, y estar listos y dispuestos a darle todo lo que tenemos, todo lo que somos, todo nuestro sustento a Dios. Esto es confianza. Este es un don espiritual que tendrá ramificaciones eternas mucho mayores para la salvación de las almas que todo el dinero del mundo.

Reflexiona hoy sobre el cumplido que Jesús hace a esta pobre viuda. "Ella, desde su pobreza, ha aportado todo lo que tenía, todo su sustento". ¿Contribuyes con todo tu sustento? ¿Dedicas todo lo que tienes, todas tus energías y dones, y todo lo que eres al servicio de Dios para Su gloria? Estamos llamados a darle todo a Dios, no solo una parte de nuestras vidas. Reflexiona sobre lo bien que imitas a esta pobre viuda y procura seguir su santo ejemplo.

Muy generoso Señor, diste todo lo que tenías y todo lo que eres por amor a la salvación del mundo. Ayúdame a imitar Tu regalo total devolviéndote todo a Ti, confiándote toda mi vida, todo lo que soy y todo mi sustento a Ti. Jesús, en Ti confío.

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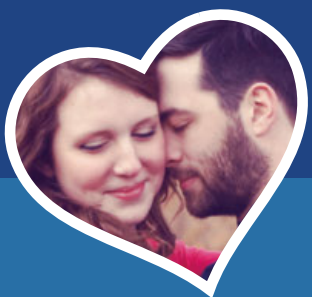
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
