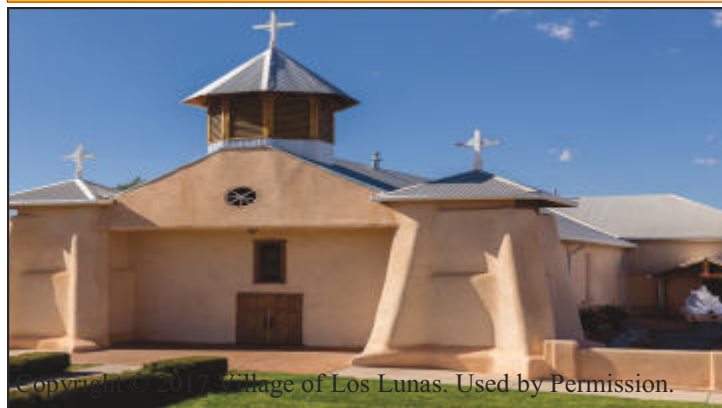

Sacraments

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Parents must make arrangements for the Baptism of their child in advance in the parish office. All necessary paperwork must be completed by the **1st WEEK** of the month. Parents and Sponsors must attend ONE instruction class in preparation for Baptism. Sponsors **MUST** be registered for (3) months prior to Baptism and active in the parish, married in the Catholic Church, and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church. Class instruction is on the **1ST WEDNESDAY** of the month at 6:30 p.m. in the parish hall. Baptisms take place on the **3rd SUNDAY** of the month during the **11:15 MASS**.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: This sacrament takes place in the Spring of each year following two years of preparation. Children must have sufficient knowledge and careful preparation so they understand the mystery of Christ to enter the Sacramental Class in the third grade. For sacramental policies go to www.archdiocesasantafe.org. Children receive the sacrament of reconciliation/penance (confession) during the 3rd grade.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION: This Sacrament takes place in the Spring of each year, and is open to all high school students. Contact the DRE for more information.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. For policy go to www.archdiocesasantafe.org.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK: Please notify the parish office if someone is ill at home and wishes to receive the Sacrament of Anointing or Communion. This sacrament is to strengthen those who have serious illness or are homebound. Never wait until the person is gravely ill. Please call the parish office at (505)869-2189.

What is Pentecost? Pentecost is a Christian celebration which occurs 50 days after the celebration of Easter. After Jesus died on the cross, He rose from the tomb on Easter Sunday. He remained on the Earth for 40 days. On the day of His Ascension, He told his apostles and disciples they would receive the Holy Spirit. The apostles and disciples waited and on the 50th day when they were gathered in the upper room, suddenly there appeared to them parted tongues as of fire, and these tongues sat upon every one of them. They began to speak many languages. The stepped out of the upper room and began preaching with this new found strength and love for the Lord. Many people were Baptized that day. This miracle was given so that the apostles and disciples could go out and spread the word of Jesus to all the world. Come Holy Spirit, come.

Pentecost Sunday

"God is always more." Have you ever heard that? If we truly believe that He is infinite, then this statement is worth exploring. Today, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit in power upon the early Church. But Pentecost wasn't the first time the disciples received the Holy Spirit. The Gospel actually occurs chronologically before Pentecost. Soon after the Resurrection, Jesus already "came and stood in their [the disciples'] midst... he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.'"

God is always more. Sometimes we might think the grace of God as one and done. God might break through in people's lives, but it's a one-time event on a retreat or preceding a dramatic conversion of life. But there's always more to come. Even today's Gospel isn't the first time the breath of God stirred. In Genesis, it's God's breath that stirs life into Adam in the garden. Jesus breathes on the Apostles, giving them the Holy Spirit in the quiet and silence. Later, that breath will stir into a "driving wind", and the Spirit will descend with flame...not unlike Moses on Mount Sinai.

God is always more. He has spoken throughout salvation history, and continues to speak into our lives through His Church and through the Holy Spirit alive in our hearts. This Pentecost Sunday, let us come before Him with expectant hearts! Like the disciples in the Gospel and first reading, let us await what "more" God will do.

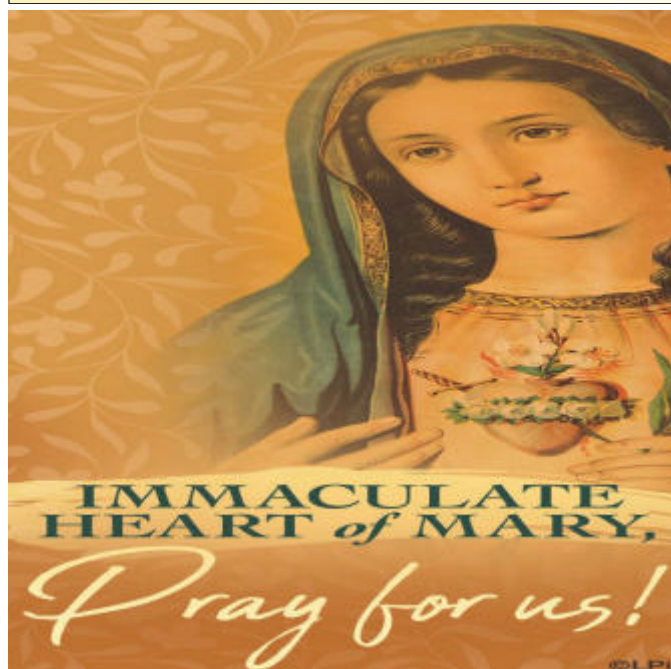
