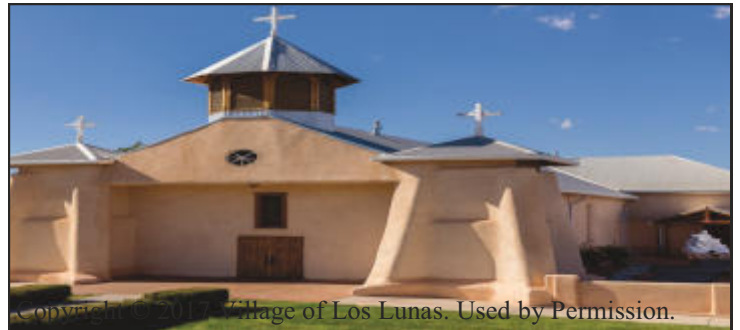

### **MISSION STATEMENT**

In sharing with others our faith, experience, and earthly goods, we grow in faith and are living the missionary call by Our Lord Jesus Christ that goes out to all believers. Our pastor, Fr. Emmanuel UC Izuka, our ministers, and all our parishioners extend our arms in welcome to all others not in our worshipping community to worship with us and to assist us with your prayers and charitable works as we walk our spiritual journey together.

## Sacraments

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:** Parents must make arrangements for the Baptism of their child in advance in the parish office. All necessary paperwork must be completed by the **1st WEEK** of the month. Parents and Sponsors must attend ONE instruction class in preparation for Baptism. Sponsors MUST be registered for (3) months prior to Baptism and active in the parish, married in the Catholic Church, and be baptized and confirmed in the Catholic Church. Class instruction is on the **1ST WEDNESDAY** of the month. Baptisms take place on **SATURDAY mornings at 10 a.m.**, as long as arrangements are made prior.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION:** This sacrament takes place in the Spring of each year following two years of preparation. Children must have sufficient knowledge and careful preparation so they understand the mystery of Christ to enter the Sacramental Class in the third grade. For sacramental policies go to [www.archdiocesasantafe.org](http://www.archdiocesasantafe.org). Children receive the sacrament of reconciliation/penance (confession) during the 3rd grade.

**SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION:** This Sacrament takes place in the Spring of each year, and is open to all high school students. Contact the DRE for more information.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:** Arrangements must be made with the parish priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. For policy go to [www.archdiocesasantafe.org](http://www.archdiocesasantafe.org).

**SACRAMENT OF THE SICK:** Please notify the parish office if someone is ill at home and wishes to receive the Sacrament of Anointing or Communion. This sacrament is to strengthen those who have serious illness or are homebound. Never wait until the person is gravely ill. Please call the parish office at (505)869-2189.

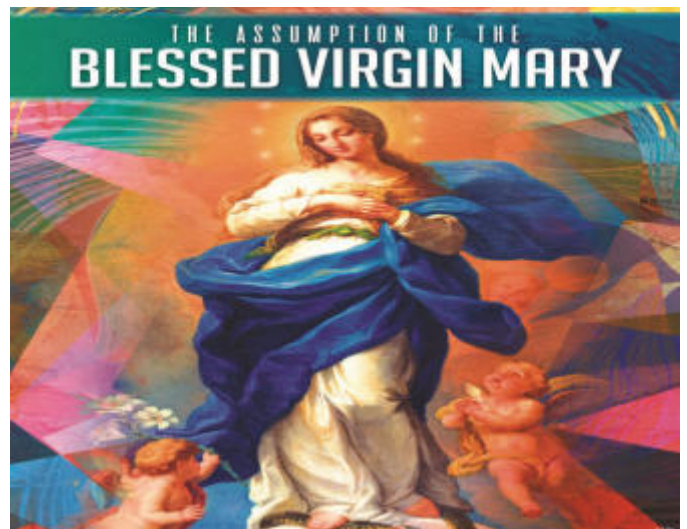
