

FAITH FORMATION NEWS

Word of God Sunday

In 2019, Pope Francis designated the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time each year to be the Sunday of the Word of God. **"We urgently need to grow in our knowledge and love of the Scriptures and of the Risen Lord,"** Francis wrote in his apostolic letter, Aperuit illis. This annual focus on the Word is an opportunity for us to re-learn some of the pastoral principles surrounding the word of God. For example: Through the proclaimed biblical readings in the liturgy, God speaks to his people and Christ him self proclaims his Gospel. Christ is the center and fullness of all Scripture, both the Old and New Testaments. Listening to the Gospel, the high point of the Liturgy of the Word, is characterized by a special veneration, expressed not only by gestures and acclamations, but by the Book of the Gospels itself. At next Sunday's Mass, notice how the Book of the Gospels takes its place at the head of the clergy during the entrance procession. The book is then placed on the very heart of the altar, the Table of the Lord.

STEWARDSHIP BULLETIN REFLECTION

NEH 8: 2-4A, 5-6, 8-10; PS 19: 8-10, 15; 1 COR 12:12-30 or 1 COR 12:12-14, 27; LK 1: 1-4; 4: 14-21

In St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians, it states "If they were all one part, where would the body be? But as it is there are many parts, yet one body" (1 COR 12:18-20).

What does this teach us as Christian stewards? It shows us that we all have equal dignity and worth in God's sight, and that if God sees us as equally precious, we should view each other in this same light. It teaches us to humbly recognize our own gifts as well as the giftedness of every member of our parish family. And, while God designed us to be ultimately dependent on Him, it seems He has also designed us to need each other!

This is part of the beauty and richness of a stewardship way of life. No one person can "do it all" in life whether in family life or parish life. But God does not ask us to do it all. He simply asks us to share the gifts and talents we do have in the season of life we find ourselves right now. It might feel uncomfortable at first. But the good news it you don't have to do it all. Do your part, let your brothers and sisters in the Body of Christ do theirs, and know that the Spirit of the Lord is upon us all as we live out this stewardship way of life.
