From The Pastors Desk



Hello friends,

I hope this note finds you all doing well. As the community of St. Albert the Great Newman Parish, we are happy that the projectors and cameras are working. I hope those are good tools to help us to worship the Lord better. I am grateful to Al Merigo for helping us with the installation process, advice and many hours of labor. He will continue providing trainings for those interested in learning how to use this new equipment.

Now, let me share some good news from the readings. Our first reading goes back about 600 B.C. The author of our passage is the prophet Jeremiah. Apparently, he thought that people would be grateful to him for speaking God's word to them. But his job of telling them to change their ways and get right with God only made them hate him. The people ridiculed him, threw him in jail and even tried to kill him. We hear him complaining to God "You duped me! You tricked me, God!" I'm sure it wasn't the first time God heard the complaint that life is not fair. Jesus' faithfulness to his mission would bring him suffering too, but Jesus was well aware of what was going to happen to him as we hear him warn his disciples in today's gospel. In last Sunday's gospel Jesus praised Peter for acknowledging Jesus as the Messiah. Jesus even promised Peter the keys to the kingdom of heaven. But Peter wasn't ready for all this talk about suffering and when Peter tried to talk Jesus out of the idea Jesus called him Satan. That's because Peter was trying to tempt Jesus away from being faithful to his calling.

Ahora, permítanme compartir algunas buenas noticias de las lecturas. Nuestra primera lectura se remonta a alrededor del 600 a.C. El autor de nuestro pasaje es el profeta Jeremías. Aparentemente, pensó que la gente le estaría agradecida por hablarles de la palabra de Dios. Pero su trabajo de decirles que cambiaran sus caminos y se hicieran bien con Dios sólo los hizo odiarlo. La gente lo ridiculizó, lo metió en la cárcel e incluso trató de matarlo. Lo oímos quejarse a Dios "¡Me engañaste! ¡Me engañaste, Dios!" Estoy seguro de que no fue la primera vez que Dios escuchó la queja de que la vida no es justa. La fidelidad de Jesús a su misión también lo traería sufriendo, pero Jesús era muy consciente de lo que le iba a suceder cuando lo oímos advertir a sus discípulos en el evangelio de hoy. En el evangelio del domingo pasado, Jesús alabó a Pedro por reconocer a Jesús como el Mesías. Jesús incluso prometió a Pedro las llaves del reino de los cielos. Pero Pedro no estaba preparado para toda esta charla sobre el sufrimiento y cuando Pedro trató de convencer a Jesús de la idea de que Jesús lo llamó Satanás. Eso es porque Pedro estaba tratando de tentar a Jesús lejos de ser fiel a su llamamiento.
