From The Pastors

Dear friends,

When God's people were in exile in Babylon, they were as depressed as anyone could possibly be. They had lost everything. They were sure they had even lost God's love because of their sinfulness. Today we hear God's prophet assure them it is never too late to return to the Lord. Even though they knew they were not worthy of it, they will have God's mercy if they will reform their lives. God is forgiving, not because we are worthy, but because it is God's nature to be generous and forgiving. The theme of God's generosity prepares us for today's gospel.

In the parable, the owner of the vineyard goes out and hires laborers five times throughout the day: dawn, nine o'clock, noon, three o'clock, and five o'clock. Twice we are told what he will pay. To those hired at dawn he promises "the usual daily wage." At nine o'clock he offers to pay "what is just." In the end, what the landowner decides is "just" is to pay all the laborers the daily wage needed to support themselves and their families. There is a fullness and abundance in God's mercy and care that will provide what is enough, what is satisfying, for each. As children of the living God, we are to rejoice in his bounty, what is given both to us and to everyone.

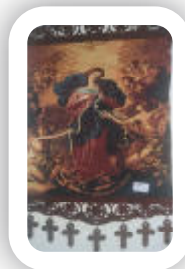
