From The Pastors Desk

Dear friends,

This weekend we have another parable similar to last Sunday's parable. The king in the parable represents God. A royal wedding at the time of Jesus would have been a spectacular event, as exciting and awesome as anything the ordinary person might get to experience in their entire lifetime. As the parable begins it is assumed that the invited guests would have accepted the invitation when it was first offered, but by the time of the great event, they all changed their mind. They do not even offer an excuse, rather their rejection of the invitation and their violence toward the messengers from the king has the appearance of a rebellion on the part of the citizens against the king. And so the king's response is severe and he invites others to the banquet. The last part of the parable about not having a wedding garment reminds us if we are going to participate in this awesome event, we must come with the right attitude. Those judged worthy of the eternal banquet must come equipped with the deeds of an authentic Christian life. Their good deeds go with them as the book of Revelation tells us, and we should have some good deeds to bring with us.
