From The Pastors

Hello friends,

The USCCB provides a document called: Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship to help us with our decisions during this time of elections. This time, for some people, can be a time of anxiety, stress and division. I want you to remember that we are a nation founded on "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness." We are called to be peacemakers in a nation at war. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that "every person is obliged to follow faithfully what he/she knows to be just and right" (no. 1778). As you already know, the Church does not tell the faithful how to vote, the responsibility to make political choices rest with each person and his/her properly formed conscience, aided by prudence.

As I mentioned last weekend, my prayer is that we respect one another, especially during this time of disagreement. If we call ourselves Christians, I invite you to really embrace what it means to be a Christian, to love God and neighbor. In your mind and heart, decide who is the candidate that this country needs in order to bring us together as a nation. Prayerfully consider which candidate will fit best the needs our people are facing now.
