Letter from our Pastor, Fr. Brian Buettner

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus speak of the Parable of the Imprudent Virgins. As they awaited the arrival of the bridegroom, several of the women were not mindful of how much oil they had been burning. When the bridegroom finally arrived, they had run out of oil, ran to get more, and were then locked out of the wedding feast. Prudence is something that each one of us are called to develop throughout our lives so that we can turn our attention away from ourselves and our immediate desires and to look to the horizon. Since this particular virtue is challenging for us, it is no wonder that the levels of anxiety and depression are so rampant in our world. For the faithful Christian, we are called to use this day that the Lord has given us wisely. We are called to develop a deep longing for the coming of the Divine Bridegroom, Jesus Christ, and to be found ready for when he comes.

We can keep our eyes on the Lord in a variety of ways. We can pick one of the Gospels and spend a few minutes each day reading and reflecting on the readings. We can carve out time in the evenings to have a spiritual conversation as a family, or even try to attend at least one daily Mass each week. These spiritual preparations form our hearts after the Lord's own Sacred Heart and can help us to remain faithful even as the darkness presses in at times. With our flame lit, burning slow and strong, we will be ready when we catch our first glimpse of the Messiah approaching us!

Para el cristiano fiel, estamos llamados a usar este día que el Señor nos ha dado sabiamente. Estamos llamados a desarrollar un profundo anhelo por la venida del Divino Esposo, Jesucristo, y estar listos para cuando él venga.

Podemos mantener nuestros ojos en el Señor de diversas formas. Podemos elegir uno de los evangelios y pasar unos minutos cada día leyendo y reflexionando sobre las lecturas. Podemos hacer tiempo por las noches para tener una conversación espiritual en familia, o incluso tratar de asistir al menos a una misa diaria cada semana. Estos preparativos espirituales forman nuestro corazón según el propio Sagrado Corazón del Señor y pueden ayudarnos a permanecer fieles incluso cuando la oscuridad presiona en ocasiones. Con nuestra llama encendida, ardiendo lenta y fuerte, estaremos listos cuando veamos por primera vez al Mesías acercándose a nosotros.

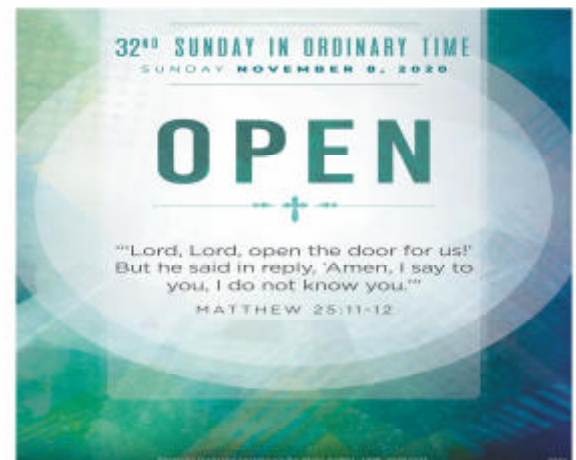

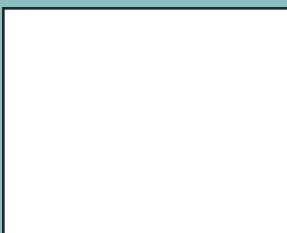
