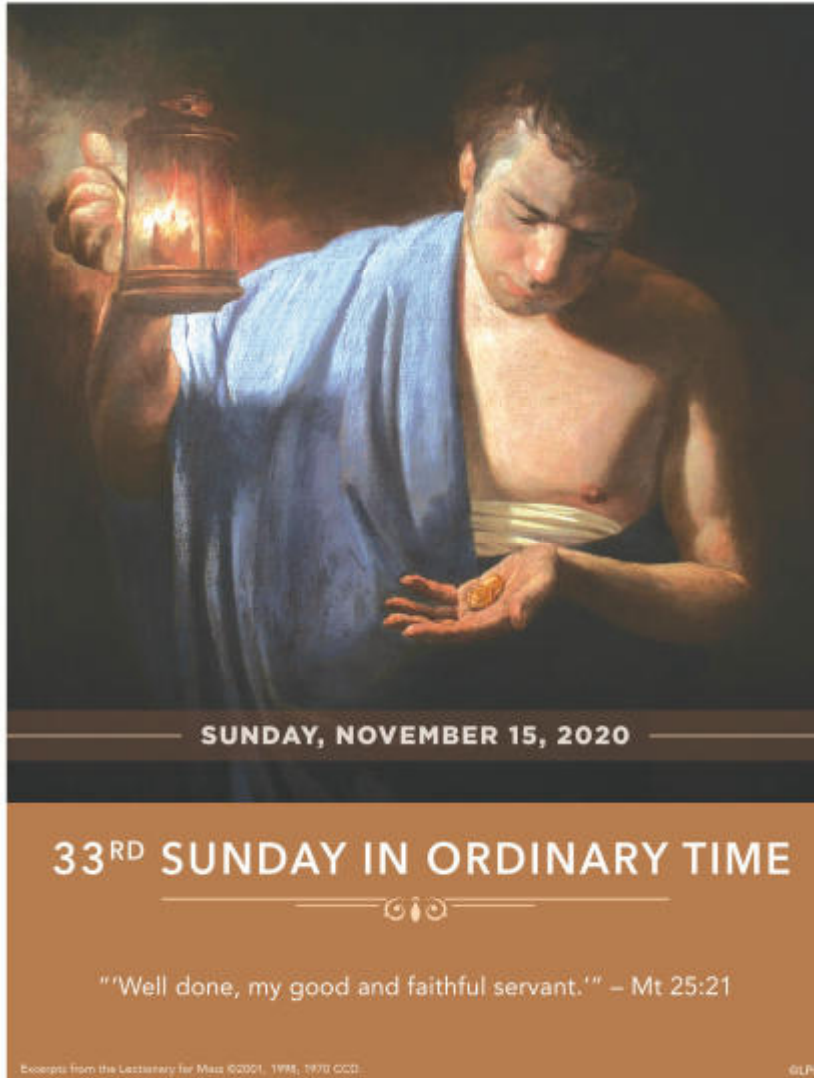

Letter from our Pastor, Fr. Brian Buettner

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

In this weekend's Gospel we hear Jesus' famous parable of the talents being entrusted to the servants. The master of the house entrusted varying amounts of money to his servants based on their ability. To the one that had proven to be the most responsible was given five talents, while another received two and the third received one. While the first two used what was given to them to the benefit of the master, the third was scared and buried what he was given so that it might not be lost. While the third servant thought he was being prudent, the reality is that he was fearful and focused on himself.

This parable can be a good analogy for us as we approach our lives of faith. We have each been entrusted with something much more than the talents in the Gospel. We have received the gift of faith, which is to be embraced and deepened throughout our lives. We have also been entrusted with our family, parish, and the wider world around us. Each of us have received different particular gifts, but with the same mandate. We are called to use the gift of faith and all that the Lord has given us to become saints. When we hide what we have given, such as our time, talent, and treasure, we become like the imprudent servant who buried what he had been given in fear. Rather, consider how the Lord is calling you to true freedom by offering the best of who you are to your family and parish. At the end of your days, you will never regret having used these gifts to grow closer to the Lord and to bring many people closer, as well!

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En el Evangelio de este fin de semana escuchamos la famosa parábola de Jesús sobre los talentos confiados a los siervos. El dueño de la casa confió distintas cantidades de dinero a sus sirvientes en función de su capacidad. Al que había demostrado ser el más responsable se le dieron cinco talentos, mientras que otro recibió dos y el tercero recibió uno. Mientras que los dos primeros usaron lo que se les dio en beneficio del maestro, el tercero se asustó y enterró lo que se le dio para que no se perdiera. Mientras que el tercer sirviente pensó que estaba siendo prudente, la realidad es que tenía miedo y estaba concentrado en sí mismo.

Esta parábola puede ser una buena analogía para nosotros a medida que nos acercamos a nuestra vida de fe. A cada uno de nosotros se nos ha confiado algo mucho más que los talentos del Evangelio. Hemos recibido el don de la fe, que debemos abrazar y profundizar a lo largo de nuestra vida. También se nos ha confiado nuestra familia, parroquia y el mundo en general que nos rodea. Cada uno de nosotros ha recibido diferentes dones particulares, pero con el mismo mandato. Estamos llamados a usar el don de la fe y todo lo que el Señor nos ha dado para convertirnos en santos. Cuando escondemos lo que se nos ha dado, como nuestro tiempo, talento y tesoro, nos volvemos como el siervo imprudente que enterró con miedo lo que le habían dado. Más bien, considere cómo el Señor lo está llamando a la verdadera libertad al ofrecer lo mejor de lo que es a su familia y parroquia. ¡Al final de tus días, nunca te arrepentirás de haber usado estos dones para acercarte más al Señor y para acercar a muchas personas también!

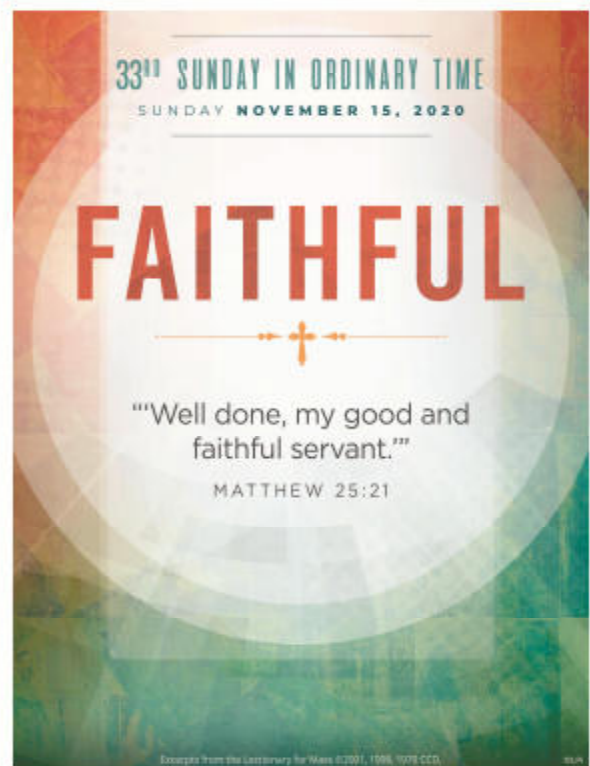

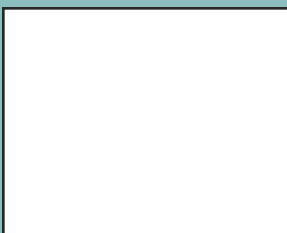
