LA EPIFANÍA DEL SEÑOR. FIESTA DE LOS REYES MAGOS.

Nos recuerdan los Magos de Oriente aquellos maravillosos días de nuestra Niñez. Diáfanos y transparentes llenos de ingenuidad pero con mucha fe y respeto y sobre todo un legado de nuestros padres y antecesores.

EN TIEMPOS DEL REY HERODES. En el relato emergen con claridad tres actitudes diversas ante el anuncio del <Rey de los judíos>: la de los magos, la de Herodes y la de los sacerdotes y escribas. Iniciamos con los modelos negativos, para no imitarlos. Comenzamos por Herodes, el Grande. Es más conocido en el Nuevo Testamento por haber ordenado la masacre de los Inocentes cuando se dio cuenta que fue engañado por los magos. Era celoso y ambicioso. Trató de persuadir a los Reyes Magos: <Vayas a averiguar cuidadosamente qué hay de ese niño...y regresen después a informarme>.

VIERON AL NIÑO CON MARÍA, SU MADRE, POSTRÁNDOSE, LO ADORARON.

La tradición los ha hecho Reyes, los ha contado como tres, los ha coloreado: uno blanco, otro oriental, y el tercero africano; les ha dado nombres diversos según las varias culturas (Melchor, Gaspar y Baltasar), en los tres regalos han visto signos particulares: el oro, tributo a un rey, (la realeza de Cristo), el incienso por su divinidad y la mirra por su pasión y muerte. El centro del texto es Cristo y la pregunta a la cual se quiere responder es la que hicieron los magos: "DÓNDE ESTÁ EL REY DE LOS JUDÍOS QUE ACABA DE NACER?.. El tema fundamental es la búsqueda de Cristo y del lugar <donde había de nacer el Mesías>. LOS MAGOS NOS INSTRUYEN NO CON PALABRAS SINO CON HECHOS, NO CON LO QUE DICEN, SINO CON LO QUE HACEN.

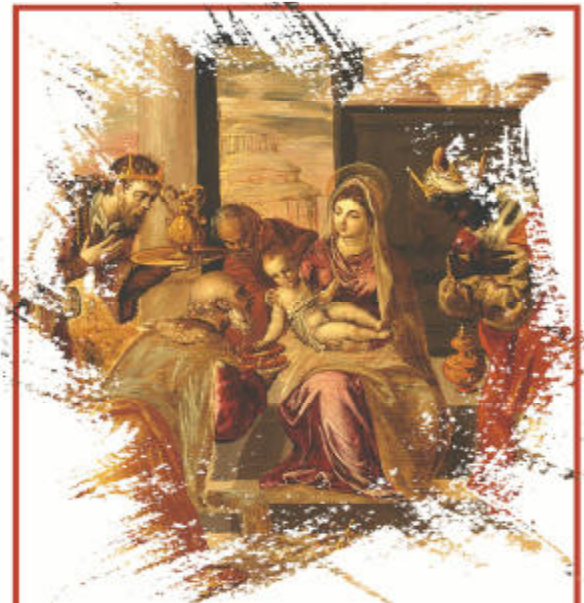

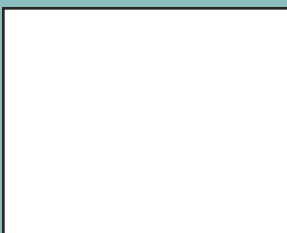
