# Welcome

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

March 14, 2021

As we heard in the closing lines of last weekend's Gospel, Jesus understood the human heart well. He recognized the pull of our heart towards temptations and sin. To put it a different way, we would prefer to hide in the darkness rather than to stand in the light.

Unfortunately, the world is constantly seducing us with evil. From this perspective, our existence can be seen as an experience of pain, suffering, discord, and misunderstanding. The world provides countless opportunities for us to recoil from God which leads us to preferring to live in darkness. As we celebrate Laetare Sunday today, we put on rose colored vestments, because the first streaks of dawn are breaking upon the horizon of this Lenten Season and the joy and truth of Easter Sunday is quickly approaching. Let us pray for a heart that can let go of the temptation to live in darkness so we can stand tall in the light of the Resurrection.

This Friday is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary. St. Joseph provides each of us with a great example of holiness, humility, and faithfulness. To celebrate, we will have Eucharistic Adoration from 8am-6:45pm and then a special 7:00pm bilingual Mass to celebrate the patron of our parish. Also, we have the option of putting aside our Lenten practices for the day. So, plan on joining us for refreshments in the parish courtyard following the 7pm Mass.
