Getting to Know Saint Joseph

When were Joseph and Mary actually married? The actual marriage occurred at the time of the espousal. The period of espousal lasted about a year, and was much more binding than the engagement of our own day. During it the spouses did not live together, but they already belonged to each other and were given the title of husband and wife. At the end of the year the wedding ceremony occurred, solemnizing the espousal.

The Gospels tell us that Jesus was conceived in Mary's womb at the time our Lady was already the espoused wife of Saint Joseph. Jesus was born of Mary some time after Joseph had "taken unto himself" our Blessed Lady - in other words, Jesus was born some time after the wedding ceremony had occurred.
