

**Question:** I am new to the parish/school. What do I need to do?

Answer: <u>If you are 18 or older</u>, you will need to go to the following website: <u>https://archokc.safeenvironment.org</u>.


#### <u>To obtain the code, contact Marcia Messner, STM Safe and</u> <u>Sacred Coordinator, at 405-973-5303</u>.

On the right side of the screen, you will be asked if you're a first-time visitor. Click on the button, "**create new account**." Complete the registration and the background check <u>in one</u> <u>sitting without interruption</u>.

After creating your account and completing both the registration and background check, you can logoff and return later to finish the following:

- answering the four background questions
- completing the training course
- signing the code of conduct form
- signing the social media form
- taking the quiz
- emailing the following to your Safe & Sacred Coordinator at safeenvironment@stm-ou.org:
  - Three references with their names, email addresses, and phone numbers. Include how long you have known each person and in what capacity. <u>Remember: References</u> <u>must be 18 or over and cannot be family or clergy</u> <u>members</u>. You can request your certificate *once your references are verified*.

Register today for *Blessed are the Meek and the Courageous Christian* on June 25, 2022, presented by Deacon Br. Peter Shults, OSB, at St. Gregory's Abbey. This Day of Reflection will focus on the third Beatitude:

Christ's third Beatitude in Matthew 5:5 tells us, "Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth." Yet, this Beatitude can often seem puzzling. Does meek really mean weak? If not, what does it really mean? In a culture where shouting and polemic have become normal, what does Christian strength and courage really look like and how do we stand firm in what Christ taught us while still communicating His love and mercy? Explore the quiet courage required to live Christ's third Beatitude in fidelity and learn examples in our own times of how meekness, lived with immense strength and Christian love, changes the world.
