

# **FATHER'S CORNER**

Dear parishioners of St Edward the Confessor, in the name of the priests and staff of our parish, I wish you a Blessed and Merry Christmas. As we celebrate the Solemnity of Christmas and the Christmas season, I pray that you will experience God's love and mercy as you contemplate the babe in the manger. What an amazing event, God has become man. This solemnity of the Lord's birth celebrates the mystery of the incarnation by which the word of God humbled himself to share our humanity, in order that he might enable us to become sharers in His divinity.

St Paul the Apostle put it this way: "For you know the gracious act of our Lord Jesus Christ, that for your sake he became poor although he was rich, so that by his poverty you might become rich" (2 Cor 8:9) "Jesus was born in a humble stable, into a poor family. Simple shepherds were the first witnesses to this event. In this poverty heaven's glory was made manifest. The church never tires of singing the glory of this night: 'The Virgin today brings into the world the eternal and the earth offers a cave to the Inaccessible. The angels and shepherds praise him and the magi advance with the star, for you are born for us, Little Child, God eternal!" (CCC525)

As we celebrate the Holy Family of Nazareth, use this prayer and entrust/consecrate your family to the Holy Family: "O Jesus, our most loving Redeemer, who having come to enlighten the world with Thy teaching and example, didst will to pass the greater part of Thy life in humility and subjection to Mary and Joseph in the poor home of Nazareth, thus sanctifying the Family that was to be an example for all Christian families, graciously receive our family as it dedicates and consecrates itself to Thee this day. Do Thou protect us, guard us, and establish among us Thy holy fear, true peace and concord in Christian love: in order that by living according to the divine pattern of Thy family we may be able, all of us without exception, to attain eternal happiness. # UNLOCKING THE MYSTERY OF THE BIBLE




Many Catholics want to read the Bible but get bogged down by the long stretches that seem not to make sense. UNLOCKING THE MYSTERY OF

# LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE

Queridos feligreses de San Eduardo el Confesor, en nombre de los sacerdotes y el personal de nuestra parroquia, les deseo una Feliz y Bendita Navidad. Al celebrar la Solemnidad de la Natividad de nuestro Señor Jesucristo y y el tiempo de navidad, oro para que experimentes el amor y la misericordia de Dios al contemplar al bebé en el pesebre. Qué evento tan asombroso, Dios se ha hecho hombre. Esta solemnidad del nacimiento del Señor celebra el misterio de la encarnación por el cual la palabra de Dios se humilló para compartir nuestra humanidad, a fin de hacernos partícipes de su divinidad.

San Pablo lo expresa de esta manera: "Ya conocen la generosidad de Cristo Jesús, nuestro Señor, que, siendo rico, se hizo pobre por ustedes para que su pobreza los hiciera ricos" (2 Cor 8, 9). Jesús nació en la humildad de un establo, de una familia pobre (cf. *Lc* 2, 6-7); unos sencillos pastores son los primeros testigos del acontecimiento. En esta pobreza se manifiesta la gloria del cielo (cf. *Lc* 2, 8-20). La Iglesia no se cansa de cantar la gloria de esta noche: «Hoy la Virgen da a luz al Transcendente. Y la tierra ofrece una cueva al Inaccesible. Los ángeles y los pastores le alaban. Los magos caminan con la estrella: Porque ha nacido por nosotros, Niño pequeñito el Dios eterno» (San Romano Melodo, Kontakion, 10). (CIC 525)

Al celebrar a la Sagrada Familia de Nazaret, use esta oración para consagrar/confiar su familia a la Sagrada Familia: "Oh Jesús, Redentor nuestro amabilísimo, que habiendo venido a iluminar al mundo con la doctrina y con el ejemplo, quisiste pasar la mayor parte de tu vida, humilde y sujeto a Maria y a José en la pobre casa de Nazaret, santificando a aquella Familia que había de ser el modelo de todas las familias cristianas; acoge benigno la nuestra que ahora se dedica y consagra a Ti. Dígnate protegerla, guardarla y establecer en ella tu santo temor, con la paz y concordia de la caridad cristiana, para que, imitando el ejemplo divino de tu Sagrada Familia, pueda alcanzar toda entera, sin faltar uno solo, la eterna Bienaventuranza. 
