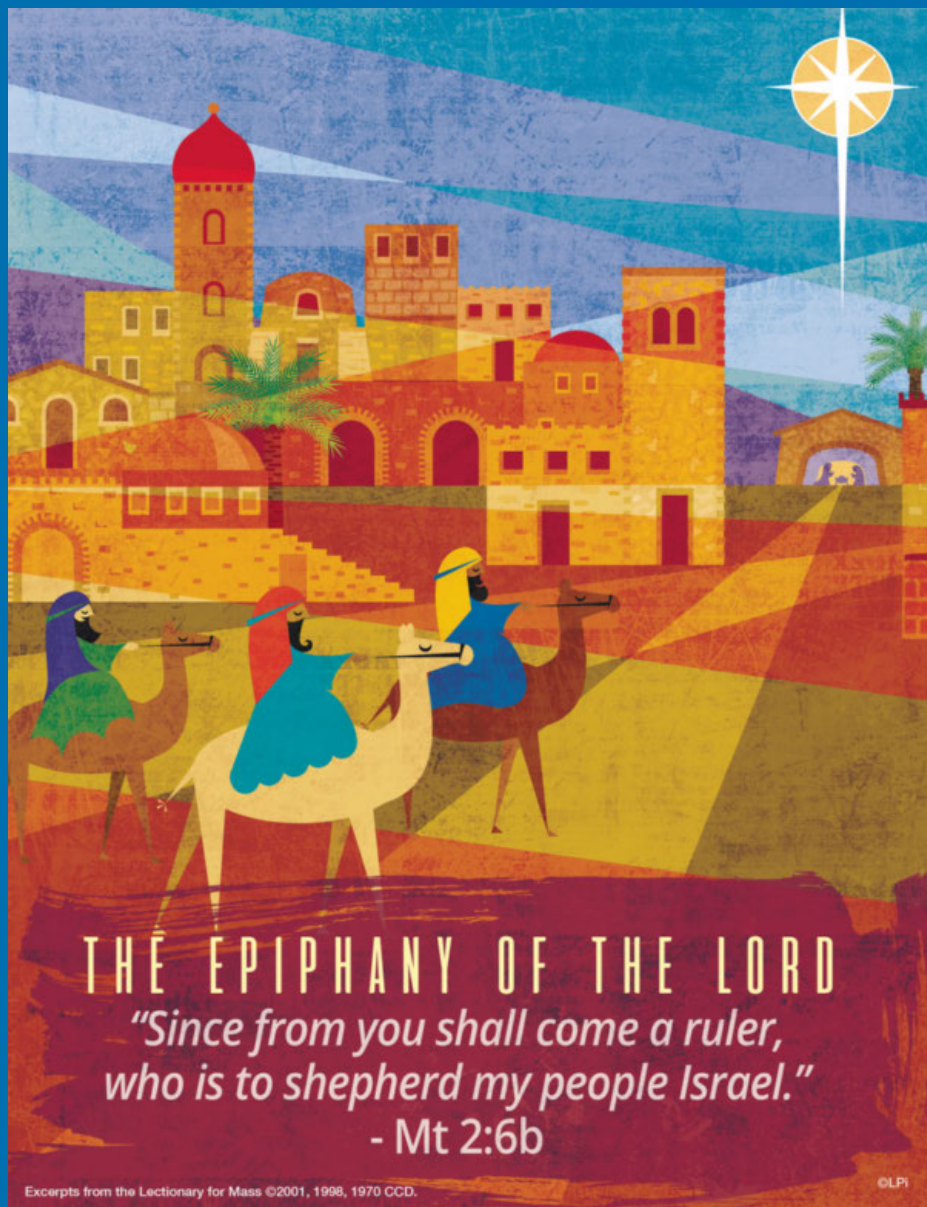

FATHER'S CORNER

Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you. (Is 60:1)

The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and savior of the world. The great feast of the Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the east, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee. In the magi, representatives of the neighboring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation. (CCC 528)

The star leads the magi to the child who is the new born king, the anointed one, the Son of God and Son of Mary. They are overjoyed at seeing the star that led them to the place where the child was. Their lives were affected, perhaps changed at seeing the creator of the stars. They can only respond to this unspeakable mystery by prostrating themselves in adoration. **They open their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.** The fathers of the church interpreted these gifts as follows: **gold:** for the great king, **incense:** for the true God, **myrrh:** as a symbol of his passion and burial. The magi, we are told, were warned not to return to Herod so they departed for their country by another way. They, after seeing and adoring the Lord could not return the same way they had come. Their path is now a new path, their lives and their time have been touched by God.

At the beginning of a new civil year, the best resolution we can take is to allow Jesus Christ, the Son of God and Son of Mary, to touch and heal our lives, our hearts, our memories, our time, our longings, our sins and weaknesses, and our families. "In Christ, the Son of God and Son of Mary", Pope Benedict says, "time has been touched and has received new and surprising significance: it has become a time of salvation and grace." The universality of salvation is something evident. The baby that is borne receives not only the gifts of those considered unclean, but he also allows them to touch him.

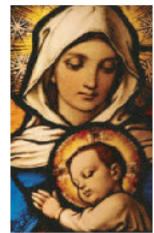
ENGLISH BAPTISMAL CLASSES

Did You Know???

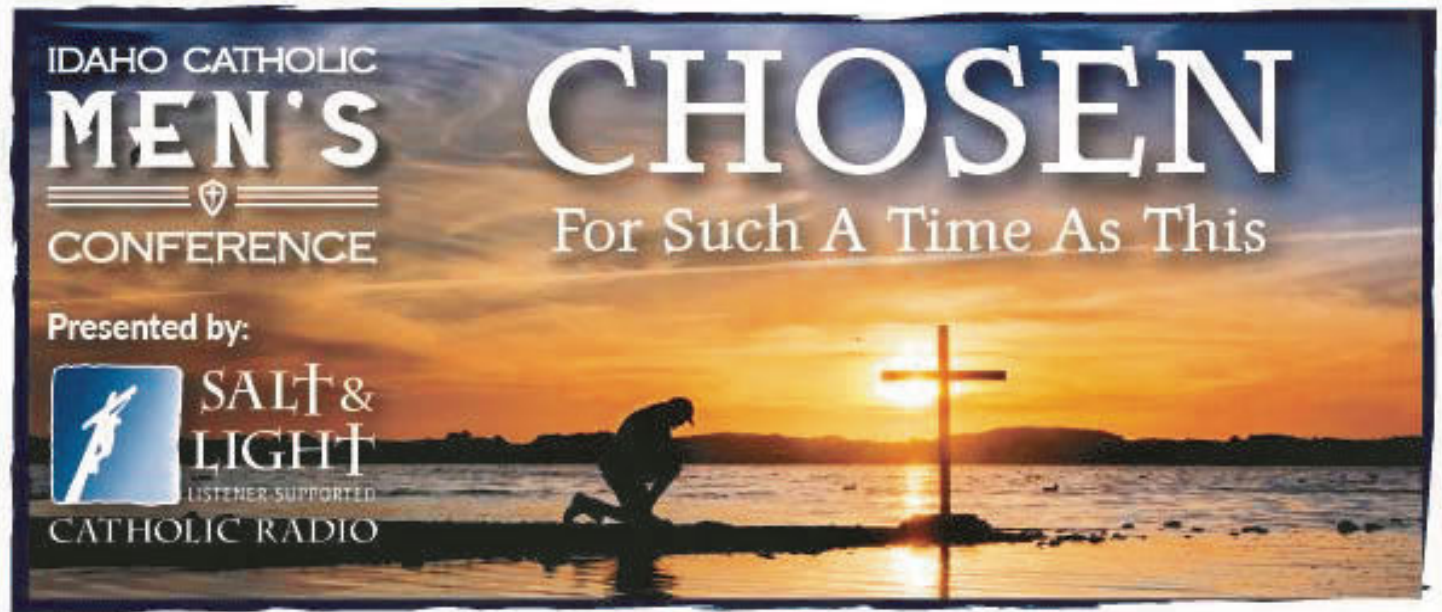

The Council of Ephesus in 431 defined the dogma of Mary as the Theotokos, the Mother of God. A dogma is a truth revealed in Divine Revelation and defined by the Magisterium of the Catholic Church. As faithful Catholics, we are required to believe these dogmas.

LA ESQUINA DEL PADRE

¡Levántate, resplandece, porque llega tu luz y la gloria del Señor brilla sobre ti! (Is 60,1)

La Epifanía es la manifestación de Jesús como Mesías de Israel, Hijo de Dios y Salvador del mundo. Con el bautismo de Jesús en el Jordán y las bodas de Caná, la Epifanía celebra la adoración de Jesús por unos "magos" venidos de Oriente (Mt 2, 1) En estos "magos", representantes de religiones paganas de pueblos vecinos, el Evangelio ve las primicias de las naciones que acogen, por la Encarnación, la Buena Nueva de la salvación.

La señal para los magos es una estrella naciente. La estrella guía a los magos al niño quien es el rey recién nacido, el ungido, el Hijo de Dios y el Hijo de María. Ellos se alegran mucho al ver la estrella que los lleva al lugar donde el niño estaba. Sus vidas fueron afectadas, quizá cambiadas al ver al creador de las estrellas. La única respuesta ante este misterio inefable es postrarse en adoración. **Los magos de oriente le abren sus tesoros y le ofrecen al niño dones de oro, incienso, y mirra.** Los padres de la Iglesia interpretaron estos dones de la siguiente manera: **Oro:** parta el Gran Rey, **incienso:** para el Dios verdadero, **mirra:** signo de su pasión de Cristo y entierro.

Los magos de oriente, dice la escritura, fueron avisados para no regresar a Herodes así que ellos retornaron a su país por otro camino. Ellos, después de ver y adorar al Señor no podían regresar a casa por el mismo camino. Su camino ahora es un nuevo camino, sus vidas y su época han sido tocados por Dios. "En Cristo, el Hijo de Dios y el Hijo de María, el tiempo ha sido tocado y ha recibido un significado nuevo y sorprendente: el tiempo se ha convertido en tiempo de salvación y gracia" (Papa Benedicto XXI). La universalidad de la salvación es algo muy evidente. El niño recién nacido no solamente recibe los regalos de aquellos considerados impuros, sino que también se deja tocar por ellos.

Como los magos que abrieron sus tesoros al Salvador del mundo, nosotros estamos invitados e instados a abrir los tesoros de nuestro corazón y ponerlos a los pies de Jesús. Cualquiera que sea nuestra situación, lo que es importante es que nos postremos en adoración y reconozcamos al bebe nacido en Belén como Dios-con-nosotros, el Príncipe de la paz, el rey de reyes y Señor de señores. Una vez entremos a su presencia y lo veamos, no podemos regresar por el mismo camino por el cual venimos. Nuestras vidas son transformadas. Nuestro camino es nuevo en Cristo. Él se convierte en nuestro Camino, Verdad y Vida.
