

## FATHER'S CORNER

**What is a sacrament?** A sacrament is an efficacious sign of grace instituted by Christ and entrusted to the church, by which divine life is dispensed to us through the work of the Holy Spirit. There are seven sacraments: Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist, Reconciliation (Confession), Anointing of the sick, Holy Orders and Matrimony.

Baptism is the sacrament of Christian initiation in which we are joined to Jesus Christ, become members of his Church, and are reborn as God's adopted children. We receive the gift of the Holy Spirit, and Original Sin and personal sin are forgiven. Baptism fills us with sanctifying grace that heals our human nature wounded by sin by giving us a share in the divine life of the Holy Trinity.

**Who can receive baptism?** Adults and infants. What does baptism require? Faith and be baptized. **Godparents:** their function is to assist the newly baptize in their Christian initiation and life. Together with the parents, they present the child for baptism and procure that after baptism the child live a good Christian life and fulfill the obligations inherent to baptism. A child can either have: a godfather or a godmother, or a godfather and a godmother. (Canon 872-873) To be admitted as a godfather or a godmother: to be chosen by parents (or by the one who is to be baptized). To have the capacity for this mission: must be 16 years of age; must be a confirmed catholic, who has already received the sacrament of the Eucharist. Is actively practicing the catholic faith and leads a life in accord with the faith. It is not affected by any canonical penalty. If married, needs to be married in the Catholic Church. (Canon 874, a. 1)

**The Grace of Baptism:** For the forgiveness of sins: we receive sanctifying grace. We are freed from all sin – original and personal. A new creature: we receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Incorporated into the Church the body of Christ, we become members of the Church and are made sharers in the priesthood of Christ. Baptism provides the sacramental bond of the unity of Christians. An indelible spiritual mark: we are spiritually marked as belonging to Christ forever. This mark means that baptism can be received only one time and can never be repeated. A person becomes fully initiated into the Church through the celebration of the Sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism, confirmation, Eucharist. Baptism is the first Sacrament we receive; it is the doorway to new life in the Holy Spirit and Salvation in Christ. Through Baptism, we receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. God makes us sharers in his divine life. We are called to serve others as Christ did.






**Hay siete sacramentos:** Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucaristía, Penitencia/Reconciliación, Unción de los enfermos, Orden Sacerdotal y Matrimonio. El Bautismo, la Confirmación y la Eucaristía son los sacramentos de iniciación de la vida cristiana. Por medio de estos sacramentos se ponen los fundamentos de toda la vida Cristiana. El Bautismo, que es el comienzo de la vida nueva; la Confirmación, que es su afianzamiento; y la Eucaristía, que alimenta al discípulo con el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo para ser transformado en Él.

El bautismo es el sacramento de la iniciación cristiana en el que nos unimos a Jesucristo, nos convertimos en miembros de su Iglesia y renacemos como hijos adoptivos de Dios. Recibimos el don del Espíritu Santo y el pecado original y el pecado personal son perdonados. El bautismo nos llena de gracia santificante que sana nuestra naturaleza humana herida por el pecado al darnos una participación en la vida divina de la Santísima Trinidad.

**¿Quién puede recibir el bautismo?** Adultos y niños. ¿Qué se necesita para ser bautizado? Fe y bautismo. **Para que alguien sea admitido como padrino, es necesario que:** haya sido elegido por quien va a bautizarse o por sus padres o por quienes ocupan su lugar o, faltando éstos, por el párroco o ministro; y que tenga capacidad para esta misión e intención de desempeñarla; haya cumplido dieciséis años, a no ser que el Obispo diocesano establezca otra edad, o que, por justa causa, el párroco o el ministro consideren admisible una excepción; sea católico, esté confirmado, haya recibido ya el santísimo sacramento de la Eucaristía y lleve, al mismo tiempo, una vida congruente con la fe y con la misión que va a asumir; no esté afectado por una pena canónica, legítimamente impuesta o declarada; si esta casado debe estar casado por la Iglesia Católica; no sea el padre o la madre de quien se ha de bautizar. (Canon 874)


**La gracia del bautismo:** Para el perdón/ remisión de los pecados. Nos hace una criatura nueva. Nos incorpora a la Iglesia, cuerpo de Cristo. Es vínculo sacramental de la unidad de los cristianos. Nos da un sello espiritual indeleble. Una persona se inicia plenamente en la Iglesia a través de la celebración de los sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana: Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucaristía. El bautismo es el primer sacramento que recibimos; es la puerta de entrada a una nueva vida en el Espíritu Santo y la salvación en Cristo. Por el Bautismo, recibimos el don del Espíritu Santo. Dios nos hace partícipes de su vida divina. Estamos llamados a servir a los demás como Cristo lo hizo.

### St. Hilary of Poitiers, Bishop and Doctor of the Church | January 13

Born a pagan, St. Hilary (c. 315 – c. 367) studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phrygia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy. Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.
