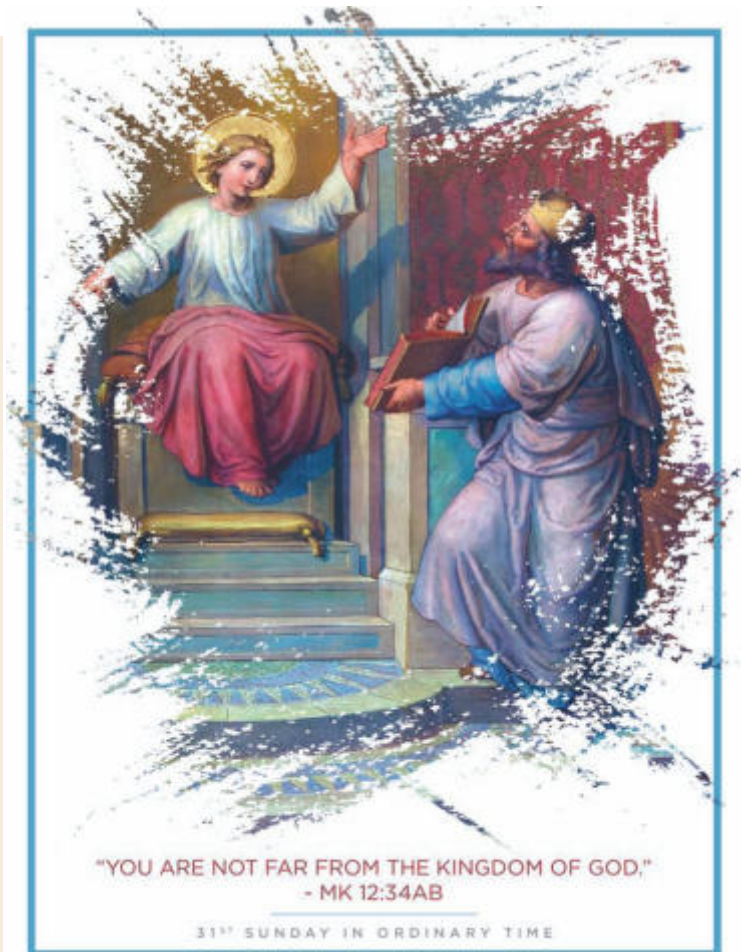

### Introduction to Saint John's Writings Lesson 9

- Apostle, Beloved Disciple
  - 20:31: "So that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing, you may have life in His Name"
  - Fiery, thunderous personality, impetuous youth
    - Asks for place at side of Christ (think of Crucifixion)
    - This turns to zeal for love of Christ ("cup of baptism")
- Very different from Synoptics
  - No need to write what they have done (Assumes familiarity with those writings)
  - Written by a much older man, having had more time to pray and contemplate (deep theology!)
  - Written for converts to faith perhaps
- Themes
  - Divine Son of God (Logos, Only-Begotten)
    - Early heresy that Christ was not God (Cerinthus (Gnostic), Ebionites (Christ was created))
    - "I AM"
      - 7 with follow up (Bread of life; Light of the world; Sheep gate; Good Shepherd; Resurrection; Way, Truth, Life; Vine)
      - 7 stand-alone (Ex. 3:14-15)
  - 7 signs
    - Water to wine; healing sick boy; healing paralytic; feeding 5,000; healing blind man; resurrection of Lazarus; Crucifixion and Resurrection of Jesus
  - New Temple (Jn. 2:14-21 (Cleansing of Temple); 19:31-34 (Blood and Water))
  - New Adam, Eve, Law of Love
  - Bridegroom (Jn. 2 (Bridegroom provides wine); 3:29-30: "Bridegroom"; 4 (Husbands found at Well))
  - "Hour" and Time
  - Very sacramental (1:14!) (signs)
  - Symbols: Water, light, fire, life

The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

**Catechism of the Catholic Church**


The apostle St. Paul reminds us of this: "He who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law. Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law."
