LENTEN REFLECTIONS

2 Unique Weeks During the Lenten Season: The Fourth Sunday of Lent and the Last Week of Lent are unique to the general spirit of penance and preparation of Lent. The Fourth Sunday of Lent is called "Laetare Sunday" or the Sunday of Joy. The word "Laetare" means joy. The Church adds the liturgical color "rose" to the environment in order to express how certainty that the celebration of the Lord's resurrection is near fills us with joy. Additional music and instrumentation may be used by choirs, also. This Sunday stands as an oasis in the desert. The last week of Lent is Holy Week. The "40 day count" of Lent actually ends before Palm Sunday, but the first days of Holy Week (up until Holy Thursday at sunset) are still part of the Lenten Season. Holy Week is identified as the Holiest of Weeks; it includes Palm Sunday, a few days of Lent and the celebration of the Paschal/Easter/Holy Triduum. The insertion of the Triduum (a three-day liturgical celebration of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday), in which we enter into the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus, makes Holy Week such a special week. It is the dramatic transition from the Season of Lent to the Season of Easter.

REFLEXIONES DE CUARESMA

2 Semanas Diferentes Durante la Temporada Cuaresmal: El Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma y la Última Semana de Cuaresma son diferentes al ambiente general de penitencia y preparación de Cuaresma. El Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma es llamado "Domingo Laetare" o Domingo de Alegría. La palabra "Laetare" significa alegría. La Iglesia añade el color "rosa" al ambiente para expresar como la próxima celebración de la resurrección del Señor nos llena de alegría. También, los coros pueden utilizar música e instrumentación adicional. Este domingo es como un oasis en el desierto cuaresmal. La última semana de Cuaresma es Semana Santa. Los "40 días" de Cuaresma terminan antes del Domingo de Ramos, pero los primeros días de Semana Santa (hasta el Jueves Santo al atardecer) también son parte de la Temporada Cuaresmal. La Semana Santa se identifica como la Semana Mayor; incluye Domingo de Ramos, algunos días de Cuaresma y la celebración del Triduo Pascual. El Triduo (una celebración litúrgica de tres-días: Jueves Santo, Viernes Santo y Sábado de Gloria), en que celebramos la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Jesús, hace que la Semana Santa sea tan especial. Esta es la transición drástica de la Temporada Cuaresmal a la Temporada Pascual.
