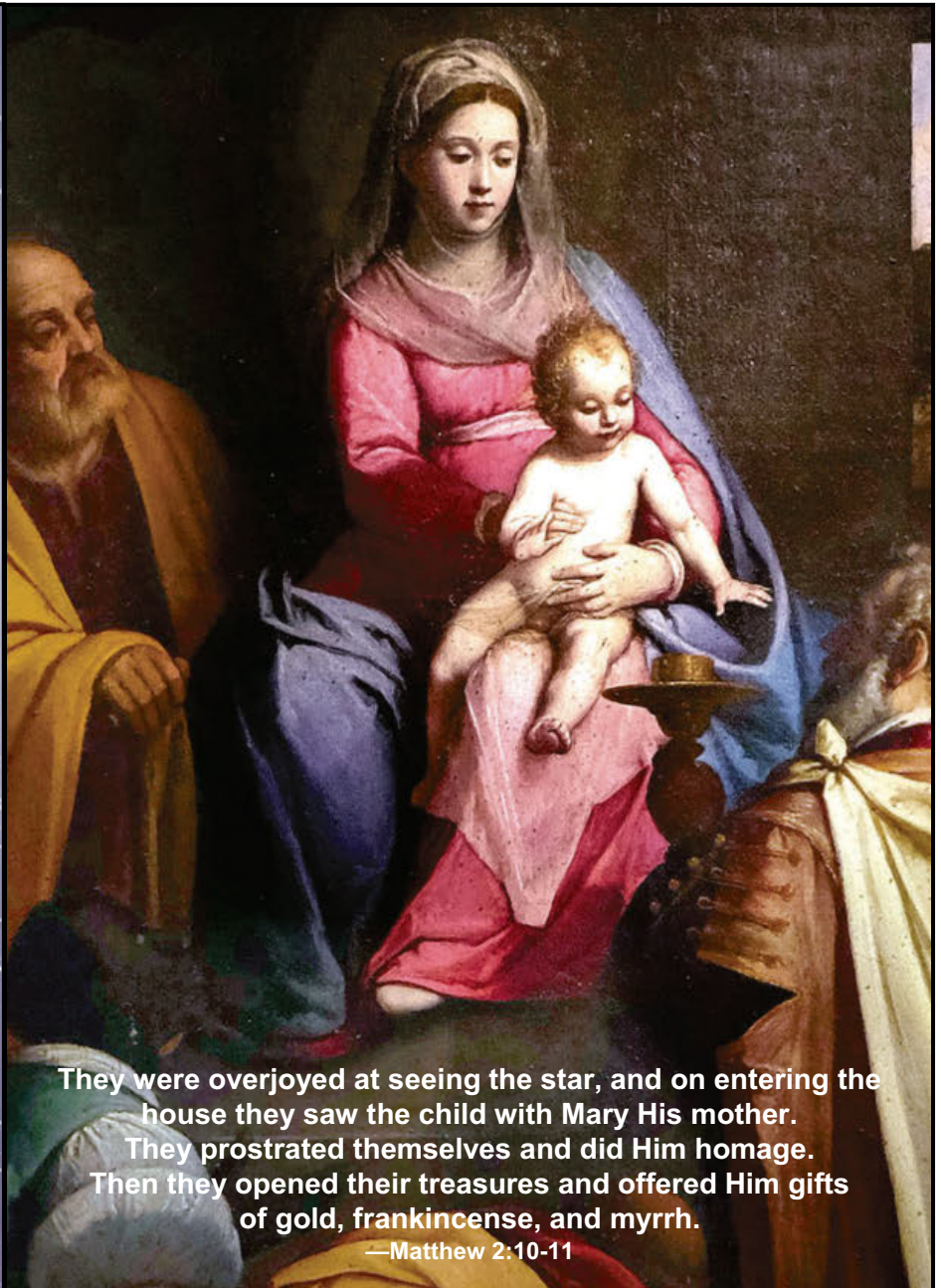

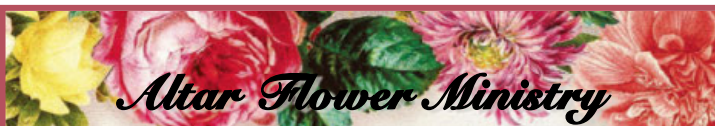

The Message of the Kingdom of God

The time is fulfilled—Jesus said—and the kingdom of God has come. Repent and believe the Gospel.”



The first four disciples respond immediately to the call. They trust in Jesus and follow him, even if the destination is still unknown, and the fate to which they are called will be clear only later.

The answer to his call must be given immediately. The separation must be total and immediate; nothing can prevent someone from following Him.

Even the most sacred affections, such as those that bind one to the parents and the family; attachment to one's profession; the need to have an economic and social security; and the desire not to lose friends, everything must be sacrificed if it is in conflict with the new life to which Jesus calls.

The Ninevites were granted forty days to accept or reject the invitation to conversion. Elisha was allowed to “say goodbye to his father and mother” before following Elijah (1K 19:20).

The parable of Jonah speaks very clearly of the dangers involved in imagining that we are better than everyone else. Such an attitude blinds us both to the goodness in others and the graciousness of our God whose mercy reaches out to all.

This ‘kingdom’ is not a place but rather a web of relationships. Those belonging to the kingdom are those who accept the life vision that Jesus gave to us and whose lives are based on that vision of life. It does not matter who they are or where they are and it exists here and now.

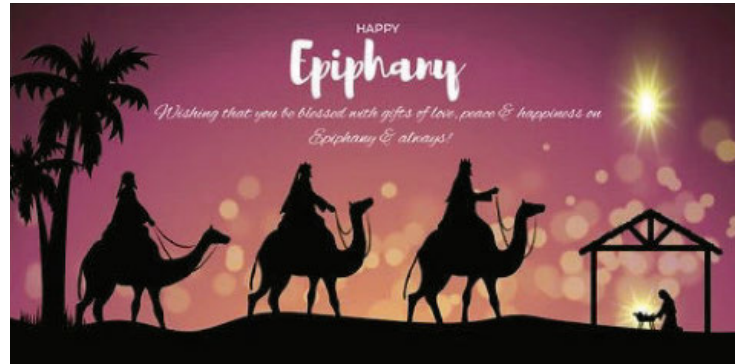

Reflection on the Feast of the Epiphany

If one phenomenon marks our modern world, it's instant communication. The message you're listening to is just one way we interact at the speed of light.

I sat at a computer to write this short reflection, and then someone took it—via the Internet—to edit and prepare so that it might be heard on our website or over the radio waves. If you wish, you could download the very text I originally typed. I still marvel at all the ways we can communicate today.

Today's Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord is a feast that celebrates communication. The Gospel we read today portrays Jesus—the Word Made Flesh—revealed to the nations as the wise men arrive to pay Him homage.

Whatever the historical facts behind the story, the message of faith is that God is reaching out to us, communicating to us the Word Made Flesh. That communication that has transformed human history.

God's revelation in Jesus has a power surpassing all our modern technological “miracles” because it speaks to our hearts. Are we listening? Are we open to the Word?

Let's become modern channels of God's communication to the world in this new year using our gifts—whatever they may be—to pass on the message of the good news, that love is born in our midst.

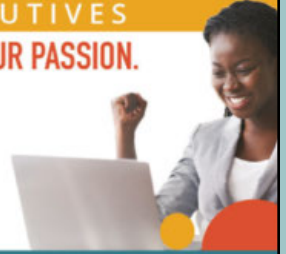

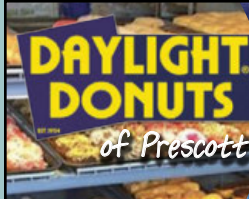

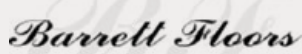
