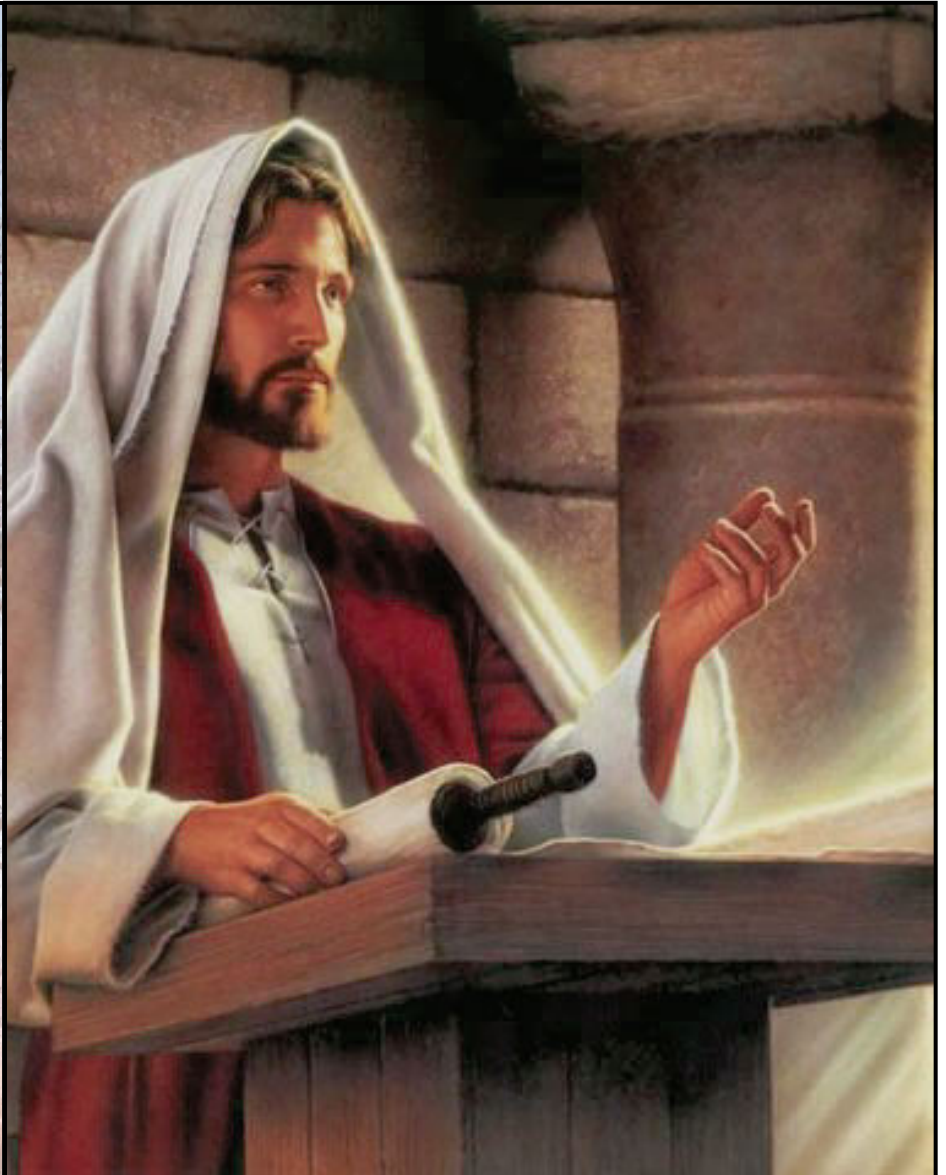

In fact, Americans use around 13 billion pounds of towels annually - equivalent to cutting down 270 million trees every year!

There are many eco-friendly alternatives to explore that will still help you wipe, dry, and clean without all the negative environmental impacts, including microfiber or cotton towels, sponges, and paper towels made from recycled materials.

The EPA notes that the production of these recycled paper towels requires about 40% less energy to produce, potentially cutting greenhouse gas emissions by almost half.

So the next time you reach for a paper towel, think again about how everything in Creation is connected.

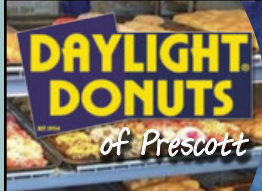
