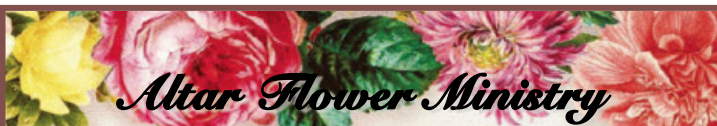

## The Meaning of Suffering and Witnessing

What is the point of suffering?

Non-believers cast in our face Auschwitz, Hiroshima, Rwanda, the suffering and persecution of Christians in the hands of radical Muslims - the list can fill several pages. And it is not necessary to look so far.

You and I experience suffering that seems pointless - and we know people endure fierce anguish. There is something, however, that we can know: suffering is the currency of love.

Service always implies a measure of suffering. By definition a servant does not do his own will. He fulfills the will of his master. We value human life very much, so we do not consider the person useless in his final illness. If he joins his suffering to the cross, that love has incalculable value.

And if you are in good health, thank God, and consider an unexpected service you can do today. The Son of Man, says Jesus, has not come to be served but to serve and give his life for the rescue of many.

In your family there are plenty of opportunities to grow in the spiritual life and in the life of holiness. In the family, one who is humble is more blessed. One who always commands and does not respect other people, will not have peace and joy in this life and will not receive God's blessing. God calls us to be holy in and through our family life, doing our responsibilities and living for the well-being of others.

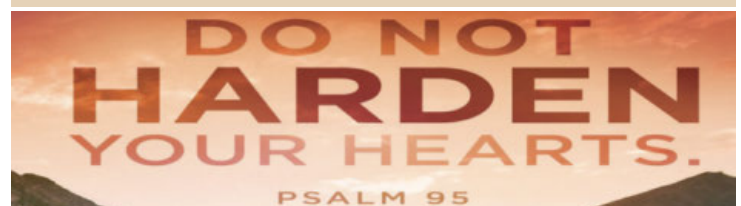

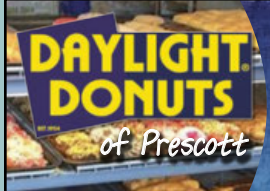
