We do manage to create a lot of trash in our daily lives, don’t we? Sure we can recycle in our blue bins and return plastic bags and film of all kinds to the grocery store, but we all know that the *Reduce* part of the *Reduce, Reuse, Recycle* mantra is most important.

Recently Juliana McDonald shared on her blog what she is doing to reduce her household trash. She calls it her *Less Trash Challenge*. The goal is to produce only as much trash in a year as can fit in a 30 gallon trash can! She will do a trash audit each week to see what she throws away and how to improve wasteful habits. This has resulted in changes such as using cloth bags rather than the plastic bags offered at the grocery store. Buying carrots in bulk rather than in plastic wrapping. Our own Fry’s stores sell celery in bulk, too! And instead of buying chicken stock in boxes, she’ll make her own soup stock. Juliana is fortunate, as we are, to have a composting program where she lives to cut down on food waste in the trash. Our own Prescott Farmers Market has a booth to drop off food waste every Saturday. Perhaps you’d like to take up your own *Challenge* with a food audit as Juliana suggests or with another approach. Whatever you decide, remember that each small lifestyle change that reduces our footprint on the Earth is another step in caring for all of Creation. Thank you for all you’re doing for our common home. And good luck with that 30 gallon trash can!

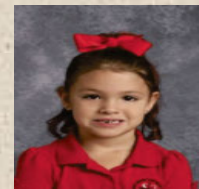
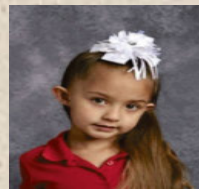

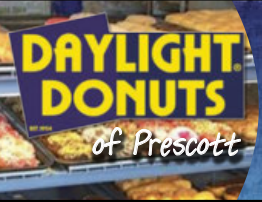
