

Examples of Christian Charity

I know there are so many of you who are generous and do a lot of charitable activities to help the poor. God does not forget the help we do for His children. You must have heard



about Pachomius, hermit from Egypt. Before his conversion, he was a pagan and soldier. When Egypt went to war with the neighboring country, Pachomius was put into prison.

While he was in prison, a group of people came regularly to feed and console the prisoners. Pachomius was touched by the deep generosity of these people. He asked his fellow prisoners who these people were and why they were feeding us? He got the reply: "They are Christians and they believe that by serving others, they serve God."

Pachomius made up his mind to become a Christian after his release. When the war ended, the prisoners were released and Pachomius received baptism and became the desert father in Egypt. The Christian charity brought his conversion. Our charity is the powerful message we give to the world.

In the second century, a non-Christian named Aristides wrote to the emperor Hadrian about the Christians. He said, "Christians love one another. They never fail to help widows and they save orphans. If they see a stranger, Christians take him home and are as happy as though he were a real brother. They obey all our rules. They should not be persecuted." The non-Christians of the early centuries used to tell one another, "See how those Christians love one another". Let us continue the noble works of charity that we do and live as Children of God the Father.
