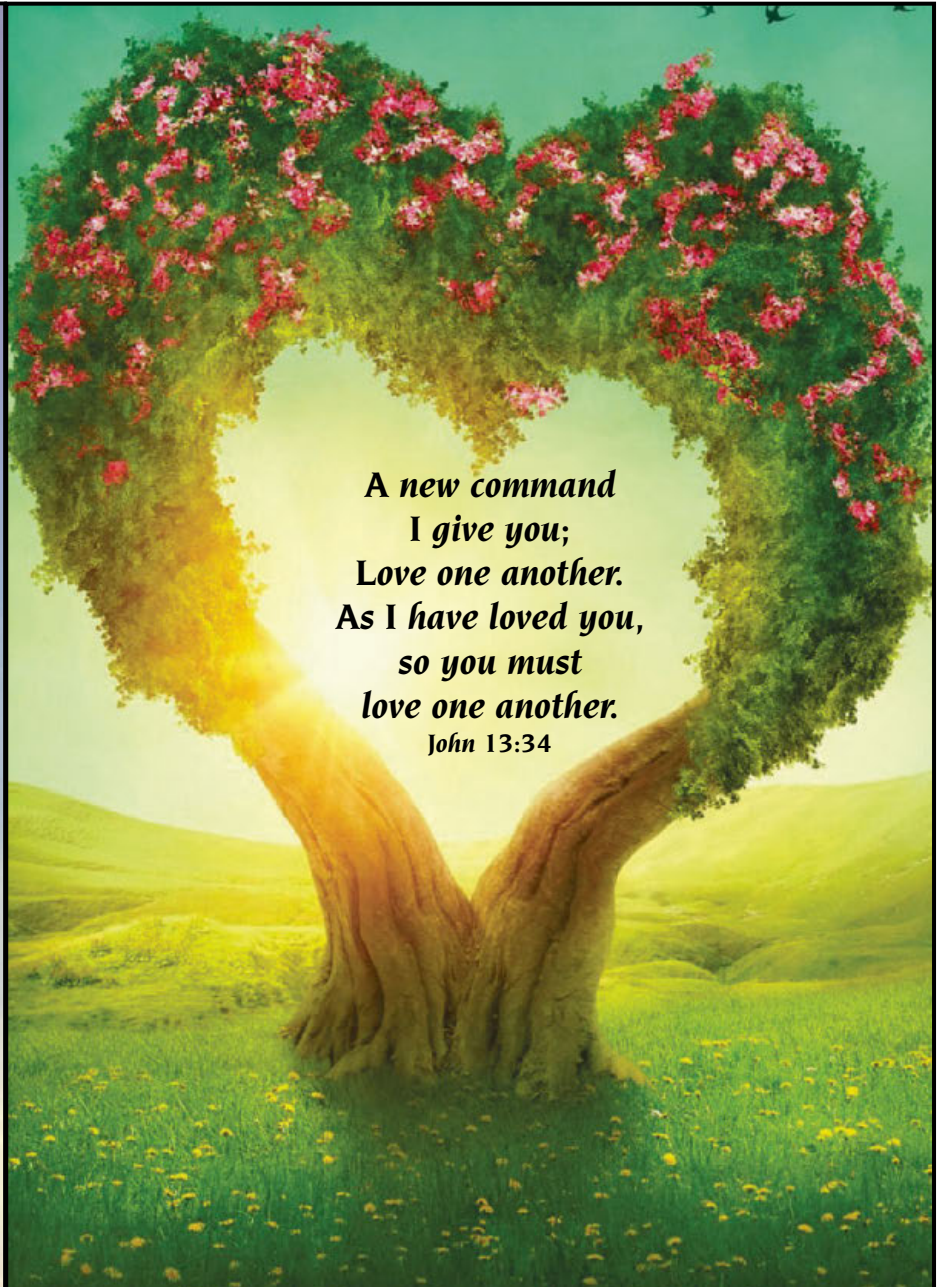

Holiness in Married Life

Marriage, like Holy Orders, is one of the sacraments of service. The Church has always spoken of marriage as having two purposes – the good of the spouses and the procreation and education of children.



The sacrament exists for the salvation of others. Husband and wife must care for each other in many ways: pooling finances, making meals for each other, cleaning the house, caring for each other when they are sick, listening to another when they are frustrated or lonely.

But ultimately the most important thing you will do for one another is to care for each other and souls. If we say that the "good" of the spouses – the greatest good is that we are saved, that we go to Heaven. It is your mission to help your spouse get to Heaven.

You must pray for one another, pray with each other – drag each other to Mass and to confession when they are lazy or procrastinating or distracted.

Set a good example for each other. Remind each other of the Gospel and commandments. Correct one another with gentleness and humility. Encourage each other to strive further in overcoming selfishness, and living your life in love for others.

People Who Care is a community-based nonprofit with programs in Prescott, Prescott Valley, Dewey and Chino Valley. Volunteers help in the community where they and enrolled Neighbors live. The majority of our Neighbors live alone. People Who Care offers volunteer assistance with a one to one situation by helping with:

- transportation to healthcare/business appointments
- grocery shopping – shopping for – on-line grocery shopping – grocery delivery
- personal paperwork
- Visiting, phoning
- caregiver relief, and more
- Technical Assistance – i.e., cell phones, lap tops, computers

Masks are optional per personal preference.

HAND CARVED in BETHLEHEM

Please stop by the tables of religious wares

Nativity set, rosaries, statues, crucifixes, Charms, etc.
After all the Masses the weekend of
May 21 and 22

Ayman Khair is representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism was stopped completely from March 2, 2020, until February 2022.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no government to take care of them and help them. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United State to purchase their articles.

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income and are able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.

The Story of Our Lady of Fatima

Between May 13 and October 13, 1917, three Portuguese children—Francisco and Jacinta Marto and their cousin Lucia dos Santos—received apparitions of Our Lady at Cova da Iria near Fatima, a city 110 miles north of Lisbon. Mary asked the children to pray the rosary for world peace, for the end of World War I, for sinners, and for the conversion of Russia.

Mary gave the children three secrets. Following the deaths of Francisco and Jacinta in 1919 and 1920 respectively, Lucia revealed the first secret in 1927. It concerned devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The second secret was a vision of hell. When Lucia grew up she became a Carmelite nun and died in 2005 at the age of 97.

Pope John Paul II directed the Holy See's Secretary of State to reveal the third secret in 2000; it spoke of a "bishop in white" who was shot by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows into him. Many people linked this vision to the assassination attempt against Pope John Paul II in St. Peter's Square on May 13, 1981.

The feast of Our Lady of Fatima was approved by the local bishop in 1930; it was added to the Church's worldwide calendar in 2002.

Reflection

The message of Fatima is simple: Pray. Unfortunately, some people—not Sister Lucia—have distorted these revelations, making them into an apocalyptic event for which they are now the only reliable interpreters. They have, for example, claimed that Mary's request that the world be consecrated to her has been ignored. Sister Lucia agreed that Pope John Paul II's public consecration in St. Peter's Square on March 25, 1984, fulfilled Mary's request. The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith prepared a June 26, 2000, document explaining the "third secret."

Mary is perfectly honored when people generously imitate her response "Let it be done to me as you say" (Luke 1:38).

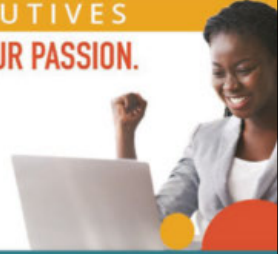
