



The Glory of Virginity

St. Paul gives a piece of advice to the virgins in the first letter to Corinthians. In the early Christian community some of the widows did not remarry and they remained celibates or without sexual contact for the service of the Lord and for the community.



Paul highly appreciates the life of virgins for the following reasons. Time is running out and people are already living in the apocalyptical age. The second coming of the Lord is close by and the world is going to end soon. So, he advised the married people to live as though not really married in the sense to live like virgins.

He encouraged the singles not to get married, because the world is coming to an end soon. He encouraged the virgins to live that way without any sexual sins that they would be better prepared to receive the Lord when He comes to the world.

All the consecrated persons choose the life of virginity and celibacy to imitate the lifestyle of Jesus Christ while he lived on this earth. The life of virginity makes them available totally for the kingdom of God and their lives call for total self-sacrifice and offering to the Lord and the Church counts on them, as they imitate the bridal nature of the Church, eagerly waiting for Jesus Christ, her Bridegroom.

Ayman Khair is representing about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East and the Pandemic, tourism was stopped completely from March 2, 2020, until February 2022.

It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no government to take care of them and help them. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United State to purchase their articles.

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this

workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income and are able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.



Stroke Support Groups Help Stroke Survivors and Their Families

When a stroke happens, lives can change forever, not just for the stroke survivor, but for family members as well. The journey to recovery can be difficult, but survivors and family members don't need to manage alone.

To help make the journey easier, People Who Care is sponsoring once a month Stroke Support Groups, featuring experts in family therapy, social work and nursing. The groups focus on ways to cope with the challenges and communicate with others facing the same circumstances. For stroke survivors, the meetings provide an opportunity to talk with other stroke survivors. "People who have had a stroke understand me better," said one participant. "People at the group have patience with my slow speech – other people don't," another group member said.

For family members, the groups provide a way to share with other family members. "Other family members understand what I'm going through," said a participant. Another family member said, "The family group helps me understand my spouse's stroke better."
