

The Right Attitude Before God

The Gospel talks about the virtue of humility. The scribes were driven by appearances. They were slaves to their vanity. Their interior security lasted only as long as praise flowed from the mouths of those around them. They were more



driven by the applause of men than the approval of God. Since their piety was a mere show, it left no deep mark in their soul and could not free them from their disordered passions.

Externally they appeared religious, but within they were a seething mass of vice. In their greed, they "devoured the houses of widows." Is our piety for show or for God alone? This is our choice: the applause of men or the praise of God.

Sometimes it is easy for us to get caught up in what others have -- what they are doing or saying. We fall into the trap of comparing ourselves with others, and probably most of the time we don't measure up! It causes nothing but anguish. Yet, God doesn't compare us to others. He loves us. He made us as we are, with our unique combination of talents and abilities. He measures our generosity not by what we give, but by what we hold back for ourselves. Remember, the happiest are not those who have everything but those who give everything they have.

We can depend on the words of Jesus to Saint Faustina: "Your duty will be to trust completely in my goodness, and my duty will be to give you all you need. If your trust is great, then my generosity will be without limit."
