

# DISCIPLESHIP

The Lord says . . . "As a mother comforts her child, so I will comfort you." Isaiah 66:1, 13 We're used to thinking of God as father, but God as mother is also a biblical image. How can we project God's maternal comfort to those in need of it?



Over the past several weeks we have celebrated the wonderful solemnities of Pentecost, Corpus Christi and the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. All of these solemnities remind us of God's great love for us and we especially observe that love through receiving the Holy Eucharist and Eucharistic Adoration.

With all of the negative things we see in the news, it is so important to keep our focus on Jesus' Real Presence in the Holy Eucharist.

During his short life, Blessed Carlo Acutis, who died at 15 years old and was beatified in 2020, compiled a history of Eucharistic miracles that have taken place throughout history.
