

Confronting the Evil

Certainly you have come across people who are scandalized at seeing evil everywhere. It is true that evil is present everywhere; in the world, politics, society, the Church, in families and even in our own personal lives.



Sometimes when kids come for confession, I ask a few of them; "Are you good or bad?" Some say "Good". Some say "Mostly good". Some say "Not so good". My point is that even children are aware when they do something that is not good. And for adults we mostly know who we are and what our sins, addictions, passions and compulsions are. The devil is very cunning and has crept into all existing systems in the world and into human lives. God wants to rule in our hearts and in our families. But the devil wants to steal us away from God. Some believers are uncomfortable seeing evil everywhere.

In the Gospel, Jesus answers those who are scandalized with seeing evil everywhere, and who have doubts about the existence of God and His power in the world. We have the parable of the weeds in the Gospel. The one who sows the good seed is the Son of Man. The field is the world. The good seeds are the people of the Kingdom of God. The weeds are those who follow the evil one. The Lord says that the enemy, the devil, sowed the weeds. What can we learn from this parable?

It is true that the devil exists and can influence human beings. Evil does not come from God. The human being is both good and evil. I would rather say that the human heart is a battleground where there is a constant fight between good and evil. When good wins, we are good and when evil wins, we are bad.

There is a judgment waiting at the end of our lives or the end of the world when we will be judged based on our actions. Those who are good will attain God's salvation, and those who are evil will attain damnation. The parable tells us to be patient and to keep doing good, expecting the day of the Lord. Sometimes we have the tendency to judge others. But let us reserve the judgment because God alone is the Judge and His judgment is just. For our part, let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, and walk with hope and courage toward Him.
