Messages From Jeremiah and Jesus

What was happening in the time of Jeremiah when the leaders, who were to shepherd, rule, and guide the people, but were failing so dramatically in their task? Jeremiah was preaching to them and trying to bring them back to following the way of



God. But as we read in the Bible, the leaders refused to listen. Jeremiah cries out, "Woe to you shepherds who mislead and scatter the sheep of my pasture."

Jeremiah had been preaching to the them for a long time, but to no avail. Now their failures were going to come to a terrible conclusion. They were going to war against the Babylonians, and would be totally defeated. Jerusalem and the temple would be destroyed, and the people would be carried off into exile for a long time. Isn't it marvelous how Jeremiah sees this gleam of hope when he tells them (and us), "The day is coming when I will raise up a shepherdruler who is David's righteous successor. He will rule wisely and govern with justice and righteousness. That will be a peaceful era, when all of Judah will enjoy peace and Israel will live in safety."

Jesus, the Son of God and of Mary, is the descendent of David. We recall the circumstances in the Gospel: Jesus and the disciples had been preaching and healing for many days.. Notice how Jesus acts.

That's what it means to be compassionate. In fact Jesus is the extraordinary, unmatchable example of compassion. Jesus became one like us so He could enter into all of our experiences, feelings, difficulties, joys and hopes. That's compassion -- entering into the feelings of others. It's the basis for reconciliation. That's how people begin to come together, when someone is really compassionate toward another and their experiences.




