


Walking in the Path of Christ



Tolerance is a much needed virtue today. But aren't we often tolerant for the wrong thing or for the wrong motive? Christian love seeks the highest good of both one's neighbor and one's enemy.

When Abraham Lincoln was criticized for his courtesy and tolerance towards his enemies during the American Civil War, he responded: *"Do I not destroy my enemies when I make them my friends?"*

When the Lord calls us to follow Him, He gives us the grace to put aside everything that might keep us from doing His will. Loyalty to Jesus requires sacrifice, letting go of my will for God's will.

We have so many desires and attachments in life. We have so many fears and anxieties. We regret or feel nostalgic for so much of the past and worry so much about the future. All of these can have a crippling effect on our lives.

And that is why Paul in his letter to Galatians emphasizes freedom so much. "When Christ freed us, He meant us to remain free."

To be fully free is to take total responsibility for one's own life and not put the blame for personal difficulties on other people. It means not clinging to external securities like money, property, status, success, achievements and the like.

On our own we can't, and we're not alone on this journey, we are accompanied by Jesus and this community of faith. When we stumble, lose our way, or get disheartened, one of the travelers with us will be there to support us and help us along the way -- Christ's way.





Listening to overlooked or unheard voices across nature is a central element for this year's *Season of Creation*, an annual period for Christians to pray and care for God's Creation. The season began Sept. 1, the World Day of Prayer for Creation, and concludes Oct. 4, the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of ecology.

This year's theme, "Listen to the Voice of Creation," was selected by an ecumenical steering committee, which also designated the "burning bush" from the Book of Exodus as the logo. It serves as a symbol of God speaking through Creation even now in the midst of the extreme heat and wildfires and other impacts of climate change that are devastating our communities and ecosystems.

At his general audience Aug. 31, Pope Francis expressed hope that this year's *Season of Creation* theme would "foster in everyone a concrete commitment to care for our common home." Climate change can feel like an insurmountable global challenge. But everybody has a special place in nature that means a lot to them. In the Exodus story, God tells Moses to remove his sandals "for the place you are standing is holy ground." God is speaking the same words to us today. The Earth is sacred. Let us each do our part to protect it.




