**The Power of Prayer**

St. Alphonsus says, “One who prays will be saved and one who does not pray will not be saved”. Prayer is the condition for our salvation. We don’t have to worry about atheists and other non-believers.

This week our parish will take a collection to benefit the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS), a collection approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years.

The AMS is the Archdiocese for the Military Services, not of the Military Services. This is an important distinction, because the AMS receives no funding from the U.S. Government or U.S. Military and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment.

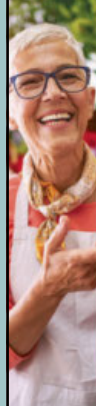

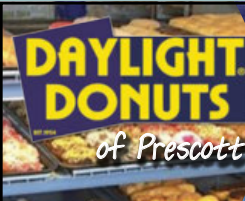

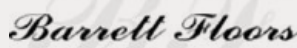
