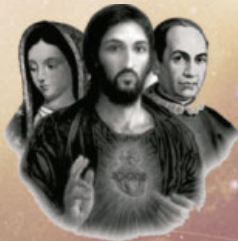

The Legion of Mary

The Legion of Mary is the largest worldwide apostolic organization of lay people in the Catholic Church. It was founded by Frank Duff in Dublin, Ireland in 1921 and has been active in the United States since 1931 and active at Sacred Heart since 1958. It is under the powerful leadership of Mary Immaculate, Mediatrix of all Graces. The main purpose of this ministry is to give glory to God through the sanctification of its members through daily prayer and active apostolic work.

Our Sacred Heart group meets weekly on Thursdays at 1:00pm in the Sacred Heart Room for prayer, rosary, planning and discussion. During the week, each member devotes approximately 2 hours doing "works". These works consist of visiting and taking Holy Communion to the homebound on Friday mornings. Members provide Communion services to the care facilities and/or assist our priests with Holy Mass at the care facilities. Members go in pairs. The Legion is, in essence, an extension of the heart and hands of our pastor, Fr. Raj.

Recently we have also included the Pilgrim Virgin Statue visitation program as one of our works. We take this statue to a person's home for a 2-week period, along with prayers and recitation of the rosary.

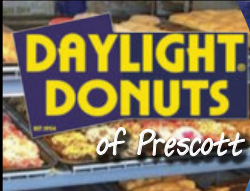

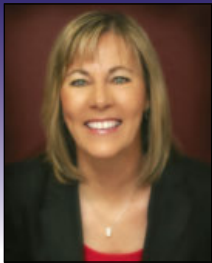
