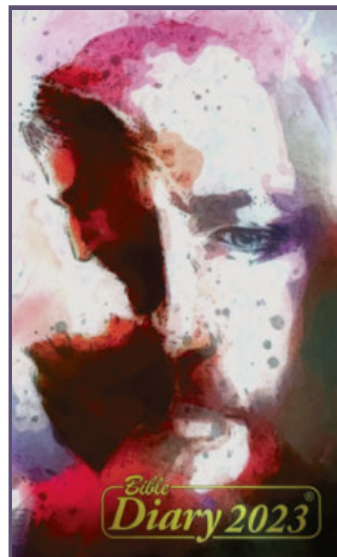

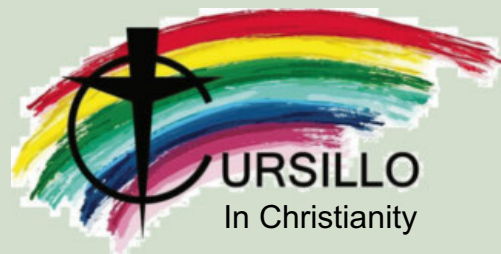

Cursillo has its roots in the Catholic Church in 1944 in Spain and has extended its program internationally and across various Christian denominations over decades. It has been with the Catholic Church here in the Phoenix diocese for over 60 years. The word Cursillo means "short course." Thus, the Cursillos in Christianity means "a short course in Christianity." Some of you may have attended the initial 3-day Cursillo in your past. We offer you the support to reengage here at Sacred Heart Parish.

Cursillo offers a simple method to seek and develop a Christian: spirituality, mentality, activity and community. Participating in the Cursillo movement provides an encounter with self, Christ and others.

Cursillo has numerous talks with priests and lay persons and dialogues about such topics as habitual grace, layperson in the Church, actual grace, piety, study and action, Sacraments and activities beyond the Cursillo. Participating in the Cursillo Movement is a joyful proclamation of being Christian. It will change your life!

Recent listening sessions at Sacred Heart parish indicated a thirst for more classes, more faith formation activities and opportunities for small group dialogue. Cursillo offers these opportunities. The next Cursillos are scheduled in Phoenix at the Mount Claret Center in March and May of 2023. Men's groups currently meet in Prescott and Prescott Valley (PV) in the mornings. St. Germaine's Parish in PV currently hosts women's groups.

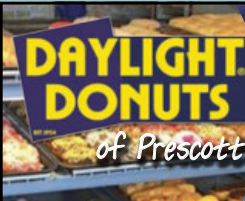

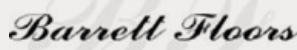
