

The Glory of Virginity

St. Paul gives a piece of advice to the virgins in the First Letter to the Corinthians. In the early Christian community some of the widows did not remarry and they remained celibates or without sexual contacts for the service of the Lord and for the community.



Paul highly appreciates the life of virgins for the following reasons. Time is running out and people are already living in the apocalyptical age. The second coming of the Lord is close by and world is going to end soon. So, he advised the married people to live as though not really married in a sense, to live like virgins.

He encouraged the singles not to get married because the world is coming to an end soon. He encouraged the virgins to live that way without any sexual sins so that they would be better prepared to receive the Lord when he comes to the world.

All consecrated persons choose the life of virginity and celibacy to imitate the lifestyle of Jesus Christ while He lived on this earth. The life of virginity makes them available totally for the kingdom of God and their lives call for total self-sacrifice and offering to the Lord and the Church counts on them, as they imitate the bridal nature of the Church, eagerly waiting for Jesus Christ, her Bridegroom.



Part of being a steward is leaving something behind. Maybe that 'something' is time, or money, or convenience, or maybe it's prejudice or a sense of entitlement. We can't expect to grow as stewards without leaving something behind.

The Funeral Luncheon Ministry is a beautiful ministry. The loss of a loved one can be very difficult and overwhelming. This ministry gives the mourners a chance to come together after the Funeral Mass to share a meal at the church. The shared meal allows family members and friends to visibly comfort and support each other while breaking bread, and to reminisce about special moments in their lives with their departed loved one. The time together at table eases sadness and strengthens hope in the resurrection, and the belief that they will be reunited with their beloved in the kingdom of heaven.

The Funeral Luncheon Ministry is an all-volunteer ministry. When a loved one passes, family members first meet with the Deacon to arrange the Funeral Mass. The family may then ask for a luncheon following the Mass. Once a funeral luncheon is scheduled, parishioners come together to donate food, ready the room for the meal, and prepare and serve the food. These parishioners are the hands of Jesus during a sorrowful time and their very presence is a powerful reminder that we all belong to the Sacred Heart faith community. 


