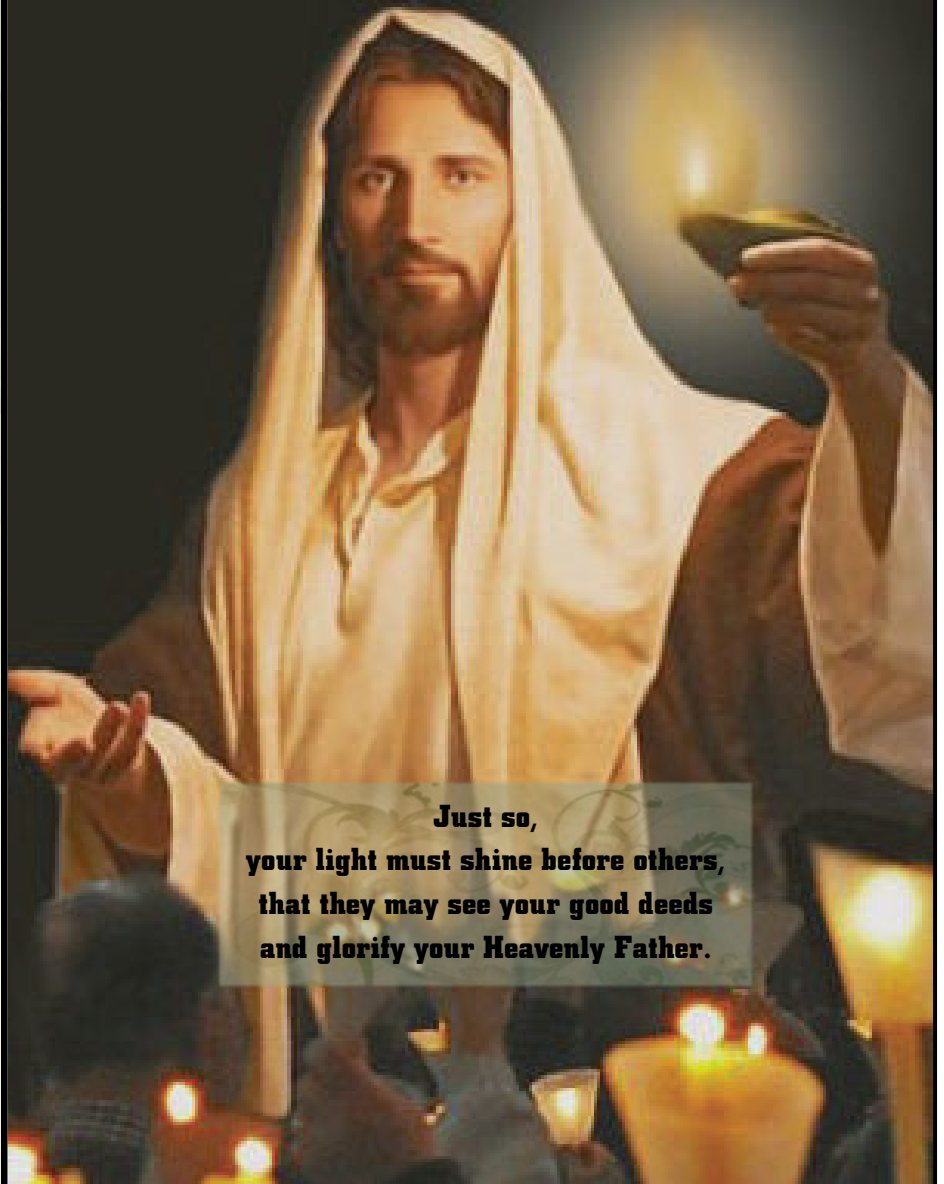

Living the Hard Sayings of Jesus



Jesus speaks to His disciples to practice more charity. See His words; if anyone hits you, if anyone forces you, if anyone sues you do not oppose evil with evil. See, how hard it is to be a Christian and to be a follower of Jesus. Jesus speaks to the ordinary folks who are vexed and oppressed by foreign troops.

Their usual reaction is silent submission that harbors hatred and awaits revenge. We see so much aggression and violence happening all around us. We need to grow more in healing, reconciliation and peace in our days. Jesus offers us practical solution, to deal with aggression. Be polite, offer no resistance, and express signs of reconciliation and peace to convert your aggressor. If we are the only ones who suffer, let us forgive, and let us put our case in the hands of God instead of fighting.

However on some occasions, we must resist our oppressors because it is the way to educate them and force them to act in a more human manner. If I accept the abuse of another, I encourage him to do the same to my neighbor. If you are strong enough, resist the evil person. Jesus does not address those who look for immediate solutions which are already deceptive. He is concerned about the people who are engaged in the slow and painful process of building up of God's Kingdom.

Our only intention in the whole process of dealing with our oppressor is his conversion. We may use different tactics like submission, resistance, and defense, so that in the end the aggressor will realize he was wrong. Let us ask for God's wisdom and understanding and let us always seek reconciliation and healing all around us.

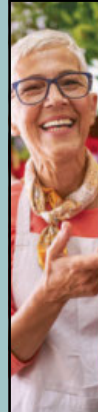

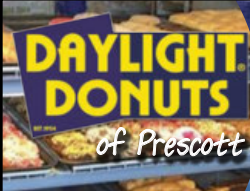
