

God loves the humble persons. The humble will find favor in the sight of the Lord. The Lord reveals His secrets to the humble. God is glorified by the humble. Therefore, perform tasks with humility. Our Holy Scripture gives a great piece of advice to all of us to walk in the path of humility.



Humility is not thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less. Pride makes us artificial, and humility makes us real. The humble person knows his/her gifts and talents, and is thankful to God for them. The humble person is both reflective and prayerful. Our humble service may not be

noticed by all. But our service will be seen in the eyes and

hearts of those we help.

Let's be clear. Humility is not humiliation. Humility is an inner, personal virtue. The only thing that matters is what God thinks of us and how God sees us. Humility is based on the awareness that everything I have is a gift from God and, therefore, I have no reason to elevate myself above others. On the contrary, I must use these God-given gifts to help others. True humility requires us neither to overestimate nor to underestimate our worth. We are of value, not because of those gifts, but because we are loved by God as His children, redeemed by the Precious Blood of His Son Jesus.

People Who Care offers volunteer assistance with a one to one situation by helping with:


- Transportation to healthcare/business appointments


