



Prayer Life of Jesus

Prayer was the integral part of the daily schedule of an Jesus' life. Not only did Jesus pray in the garden and in quiet places, but Jesus also prayed in the synagogue and in the temple. He would have said the *Shema*, the daily prayer of a faithful Jew, about loving God with all our heart and soul.



The Gospel of Luke is called a Gospel of prayer because Luke records about prayer life and prayer habits of Jesus more than other Gospels. Our Lord's Prayer is a prayer for all seasons. It also gives us insight into how Jesus prayed. For Jesus, prayer was seeking communion with God the Father and doing His will.

Theologically speaking, there are at least three reasons that Jesus prayed. First, Jesus prayed as an example to his followers. Second, the Incarnation consists of both divine and human natures. From His human nature, it was perfectly natural for a Jewish believer such as Christ to pray. Third, the nature of the Trinity allows for communication between its members. As God the Son, Jesus could pray to God the Father.

Jesus Himself prayed for others. In the Gospel of John chapter 17, we read the priestly prayer of Jesus. Jesus is praying for His disciples and followers. This underscores the need for intercessory prayer.

What is a Eucharistic Miracle?

Eucharistic Miracles are extraordinary events or phenomena which manifest the Real Presence of Jesus in the consecrated bread and wine in a way that we can discern with our ordinary senses. The manifestation may be as simple as a host floating on air, or as astonishing as a host becoming visible human flesh.

Blessed Carlo Acutis



"To always be close to Jesus, that's my life plan" With these few words Carlo Acutis, the boy who died of leukemia, outlines the distinguishing feature of his brief existence: to live with Jesus, of Jesus, and in Jesus.

This international exhibition was created and designed by Blessed Carlo Acutis in 2002. It consists of an extensive collection of photographs and historical records representing a sampling of ancient and modem Eucharistic Miracles that have taken place in various parts of the world. The collection was then assembled by the Vatican to mark the Year of the Eucharist (October 2004 - October 2005). After being shown at more than 500 parishes in Italy, it is now traveling the rest of the world.

Bring the Exhibit to your Parish or School

The exhibition brought to Prescott is comprised of 53 panels (2ft x 3 ft) in English and 53 in Spanish, detailing 47 different miracles (some miracles having multiple panels). The miracles span a period of approximately 1500 years with the most recent one occurring in 2013. The miracles featured are from Europe, Asia, and the Americas. The exhibition offers you a 'virtual tour' of these veritable treasures of our faith.

To assemble the Easter Food boxes, we are asking for the following items:


