



Faith Aspect of Prayer Life


The relationship with God is prayer.



Children's Liturgy of the Word

(C.L.O.W.)

Children's Liturgy of the Word or CLOW is a ministry that allows children ages 5 – 10 years of age to celebrate the word of God separate from the general assembly. The primary purpose of dismissing children during the Liturgy of the Word is to provide them a more focused environment where they are more likely to become conscious, active listeners and responders to God's Word.

After the Introductory Rite, the Priest calls the children forward to be formally dismissed to another room for the Liturgy of the Word. They have a welcoming prayer, hear the First Reading, sing a Responsorial Psalm, sing the Gospel Acclamation, hear the Gospel, and then participate in a discussion of the message of the readings. They also recite the Apostle's Creed and offer prayers for their intentions before returning to Mass before the Liturgy of the Eucharist begins.

The purpose of CLOW is not to babysit or provide entertainment for children, but to open young people to hear and respond to God's Word in ways that enable them to be nurtured and challenged. CLOW is offered at the Sunday evening 5:00pm Mass and at the 1:00pm Spanish Mass during the normal school year. It is facilitated by 2-3 fully trained adults with hearts open to sharing the faith with children.


