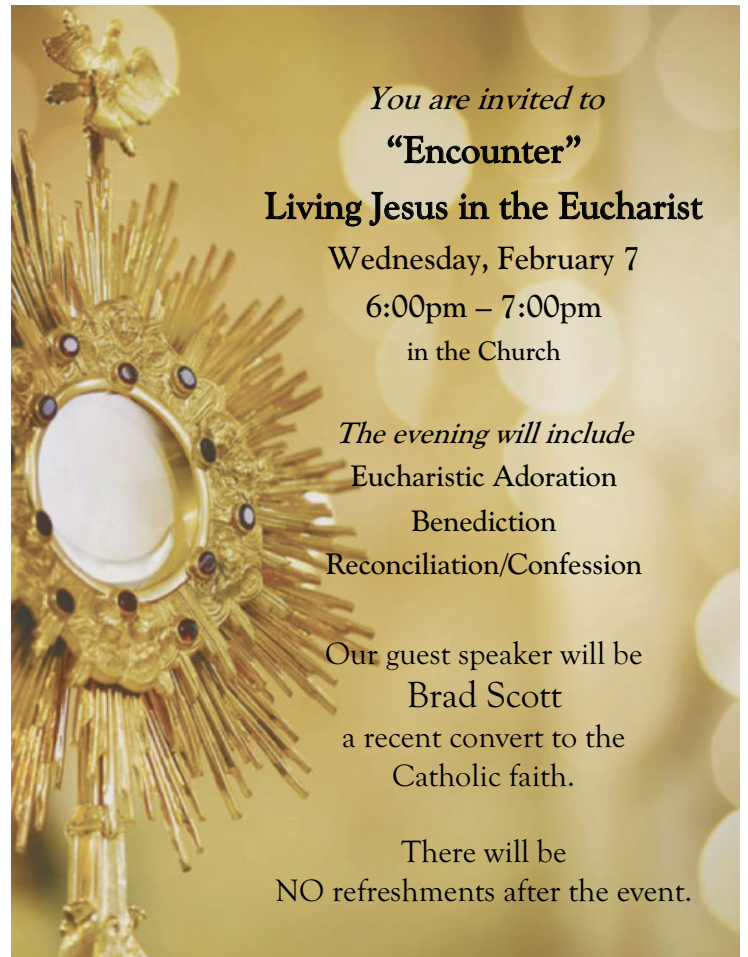

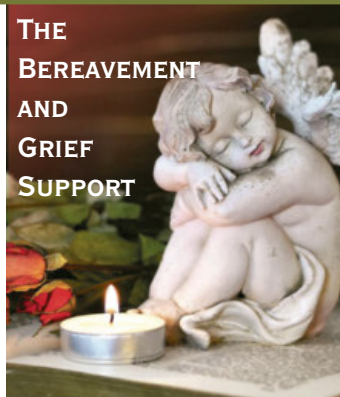

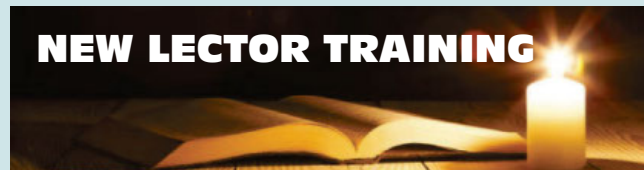

Lenten Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Saint Joseph to support World Youth Day 2027

Immediately after His baptism by John the Baptist, Jesus ventured into the Judean Desert for 40 days and nights where he prayed, fasted, and resisted the temptations of the devil. During this time, Satan tested Him repeatedly. With each test, Jesus answered with the wisdom of God. Today, we recognize those 40 days in the Judean Desert on the Liturgical Calendar as Lent.

When His time in the desert was completed, Jesus went to Galilee, proclaiming the good news. He began laying the visible foundations of His Church, the Universal Church, the Catholic Church.

Each year, Catholics give something up for Lent, known as a Lenten Sacrifice or Lenten Penitence. This year, Sacred Heart Parishioners may also consider participating in or financially supporting a Lenten Pilgrimage to the Shrine of Saint Joseph in Yarnell. St. Joseph is the Patron Saint of the Universal Church. This pilgrimage can help grow a spiritual relationship with Christ. The Pilgrimage will take place on Saturday March 23rd, the day before Palm Sunday. It will also support the youth in our Catholic community as they begin preparations for the next World Youth.

Almost 40 years ago, in 1984, Pope Saint John Paul II *"decided to organize a gathering on Palm Sunday, in Rome, to celebrate the Youth Jubilee of the Holy Year of Redemption 1983-1984."* Sixty thousand youth were expected to attend; two hundred and fifty thousand showed up. The excitement at seeing that many young people seeking a relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ was so great that the Church and Pope John Paul II planned another event for the following year: this time three hundred thousand turned out. Buoyed by the repeated interest, World Youth Day became an ongoing celebration. There have been sixteen more celebrations since, for a total of eighteen, the most recent of which was in 2023 in Lisbon, Portugal. The next will celebration will be held in Seoul, South Korea in 2027. As stated in its mission, World Youth Day carries *"forth the beacon of faith, community, and spiritual enlightenment, connecting youth across the globe with the timeless teachings of Christ."*

Sacred Heart Parish sent seven young parishioners to Portugal in 2023 to grow in their faith, to have fellowship with their Catholic community beyond Prescott, and to further develop their spiritual enlightenment. Wouldn't it be fantastic if we could send twice that number to South Korea in 2027?

World Youth Day celebrations are meant to bring together young Catholics from every corner of the globe, but they are expensive and not everyone can afford the cost. To help our youth in their faith journey, Sacred Heart Parish created a scholarship fund. Your participation in or financial support of the Pilgrimage to Shrine of Saint Joseph will help build this scholarship fund. By walking the entire route, some of the route, offering logistical support, or financially contributing to the fund, you demonstrate your commitment to sacrificing for our Lord Jesus Christ and to growing His Church.

Tomorrow's shepherds will come from today's flock. Let us do our part in helping them to strengthen their relationships with Christ and with their Catholic community.

Walking Through the Mass The Parts of the Liturgy of the Eucharist

As we continue our journey through the Mass, we come to the **Liturgy of the Eucharist**. Growing up as an altar server, the preparation for the Liturgy of the Eucharist was always one of the most action-packed moments of the Mass. There are several things to bring to the altar and an order to how they should arrive. As we have noted, every part of the Mass has a background and a significant meaning, even some of the quick (and sometimes quiet) gestures in this part of the Mass. There are special cloths, shiny chalices, candles, bread, wine, and water, among many other things. All of them will serve a purpose, and with the words of Christ, the bread and wine will become Christ himself—**his true Body and Blood**—his true presence with us!

What is the Liturgy of the Eucharist

As the *General Instruction for the Roman Missal* teaches, “At the Last Supper Christ instituted the Paschal Sacrifice and banquet, by which the Sacrifice of the Cross is continuously made present in the Church whenever the Priest, representing Christ the Lord, carries out what the Lord himself did and handed over to his disciples to be done in his memory. For Christ took the bread and the chalice and gave thanks, broke the bread and gave it to his disciples, saying, ‘Take, eat, and drink: this is my Body; this is the chalice of my Blood. Do this in memory of me.’ Hence, the Church has arranged the entire celebration of the Liturgy of the Eucharist in parts corresponding to precisely these words and actions of Christ, namely:

- At the Preparation of the Gifts, the bread and the wine with water are brought to the altar—the same elements, that is to say, which Christ took into his hands.
- In the Eucharistic Prayer, thanks is given to God for the whole work of salvation, and the offerings become the Body and Blood of Christ.

Through the fraction and through Communion, the faithful, though many, receive from the one bread the Lord’s Body and from the one chalice the Lord’s Blood in the same way the Apostles received them from the hands of Christ himself” (*GIRM*, 72).

The Parts of the Liturgy of the Eucharist

For an in-depth summary of the parts of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, we turn to the *Catholic Encyclopedia*: “The Liturgy of the Eucharist, the essential part of the sacrifice, includes: the preparation of the altar; the preparation of the gifts: bread, wine, and water are brought to the altar ([and in many places] the money offerings or offerings for the poor), [typically] the offertory song is sung during this preparation; the priest washes his hands; an invitation to prayer is prayed by the priest. There follows the

Before you are scheduled for the training class, you will need to have completed the Safe Environment training which you can complete online. If you do not have access to a computer to take the online training, please call the church office. They will help you to take the training at the church.

To take the Safe Environment Training go to the Diocese of Phoenix website and look for the Child Protection site. Follow the directions to complete the training.

After you have completed the Safe Environment training, call Shirley King at (928) 445-8912 to register for the training class. Please register for the class by January 31.

A commissioning ceremony for all newly trained ministers will be held at the 9:00am Mass on Sunday, February 18th.

The Parts of the Liturgy of the Eucharist continue

Eucharistic prayer, which is a prayer of thanksgiving and sanctification and the center of the Eucharistic celebration. It contains: the preface, expressing thanksgiving in the name of the entire people of God; the acclamation or *sanctus* (holy, holy, holy), which is recited by the priest and people or sung, the Eucharistic prayer; the invocations for the Church, the epiclesis; narration of the institution and consecration of the bread and wine in the words of Christ; the fulfillment of the command given by Christ to the Church to carry on this mystery of the sacrifice, called the anamnesis; the offering of the victim to God the Father in the Holy Spirit; the intercessions for the living and the dead and for the faithful present; the final doxology, and concluding Amen” (*Catholic Encyclopedia*, Thomas Nelson Inc., Nashville, 1976, p. 197).

Now *that* is a table of contents! Although this listing may seem complex, we’ll be taking each section one at a time, breaking it down so we can understand the importance of each part in the Mass and its importance for us. As we journey through the parts of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, remind yourself that these pieces all serve a grand purpose: our pathway to the true presence of Christ on the altar at Mass!

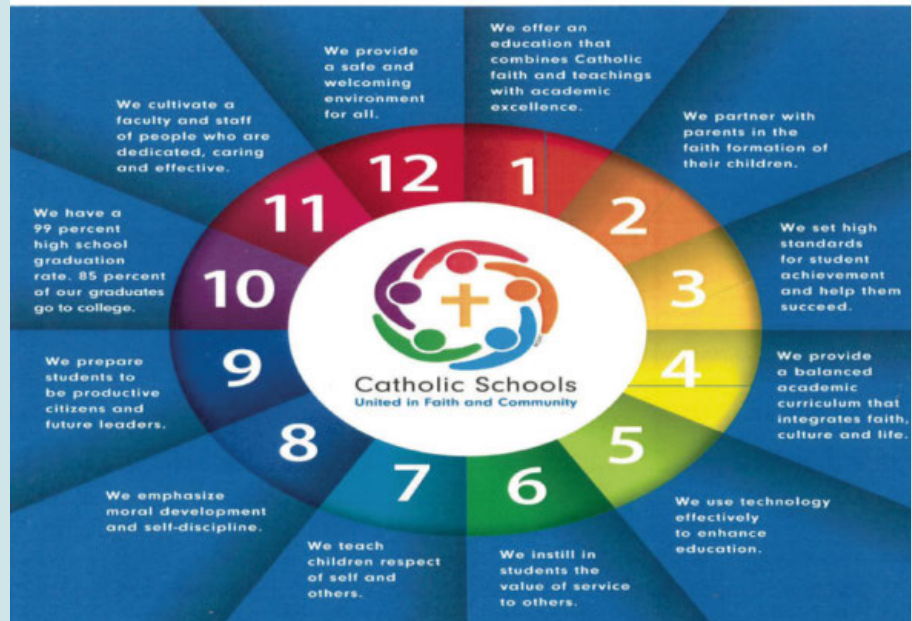

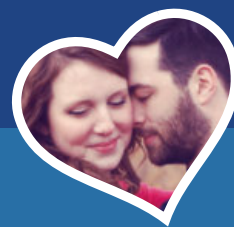
