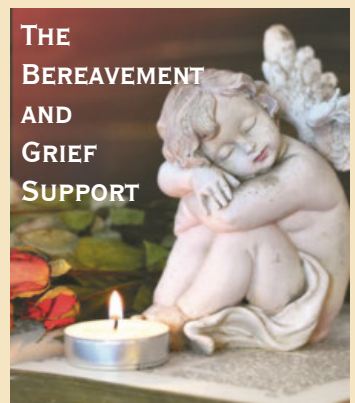
ARE YOU, OR SOMEONE YOU KNOW, SUFFERING FROM THE LOSS OF A LOVED ONE?
